Morten Andersen, Chiefs	Most points (has 2,259).	88 points
Jerome Bettis, Steelers	Fourth place all-time rushing yards.	907
Tim Brown, Raiders	Second player with 10 seasons of at least 1,000 yards receiving.	1,000 receiving yards
Daunte Culpepper, Vikings	Most seasons with 3,000 passing yards and 400 rushing yards.	3,000 passing/400 rushing
Brett Favre, Packers	First player with 11 consecutive seasons of 20 TD passes. First quarterback to start 200 consecutive games. Second player to throw 350 touchdowns. Third player to pass for 47,000 yards.	3,676 passing yards 4 TD passes 20 TD passes 11 consecutive starts
Marvin Harrison, Colts	First player with five consecutive 100 catch seasons. Most 1,500-yard receiving seasons.	100 receptions 1,500 receiving yards
Peyton Manning, Colts	First player with 4,000 yards passing in six consecutive seasons. First player to throw for 25 TDs in seven consecutive seasons.	4,000 passing yards 25 TD passes
Curtis Martin, Jets	First player with 250 carries in each of first 10 seasons. Second player with 1,000 yards rushing in first 10 seasons.	250 carries 1,000 rushing yards
Steve McNair, Titans	Most seasons with 3,000 passing yards and 400 rushing yards.	3,000 passing/400 rushing
Randy Moss, Vikings	First player with 1,000 yards receiving in first seven seasons.	1,000 receiving yards
Clinton Portis, Redskins	First player to rush for 1,500 yards in first three seasons.	1,500 rushing yards
Jerry Rice, Raiders	First player with 24,000 yards from scrimmage. First player with 23,000 yards receiving. First player with 200 career receiving touchdowns.	889 yards from scrimmage 534 receiving yards 6 TD receptions
Emmitt Smith, Cardinals	First player with 18,000 yards rushing.	582 rushing yards
LaDainian Tomlinson, Chargers	First running back with 100 receptions in consecutive seasons.	100 receptions
