## THE LONG-SNAPPING MAGICIAN

When Buffalo Bills long snapper **JON DORENBOS** was 12 years old, he watched in awe as a 16-year-old magician performed magic before his eyes.

Shortly after, Jon bought his first book of magic entitled "Coin Magic" by JB Bobo. He has since been addicted with the tediousness and repetitiveness that is necessary to become a successful magician. "I love the psychology of deception, the timing of misdirection, and the ability to manipulate what people think they see," says Dorenbos.

With magic, you can make a mistake and continue with your trick like nothing has happened, but with long snapping there is no room for error -- make a mistake and everyone notices. But that doesn't mean you can hold back, says Dorenbos. "Long snapping is just like magic in that you can't hesitate," he says. You have to trust your preparation, trust all the hard work and time you put into it, and when it's game time, you just have to go out there and take care of business."

When Dorenbos is not taking care of business on the field, he is a professional magician off it. <u>Here are five of his favorite magic</u> <u>tricks</u>:

## TOP TRICKS

- 1. <u>Houdini's Needles</u>: Jon places 10-15 needles in his mouth with a piece of string, swallows them, and then pulls the string out of his mouth with the string thread through all the needles.
- 2. <u>The Watch Steal</u>: The classic, "How-did-you-steal-my-watch-while-l-was-watching-you-the-whole-time?" trick
- 3. <u>Boomer the Mouse</u>: Jon's assistant, a pet mouse, is also a key element to Jon's success. He's not a really a magic trick, but Jon dresses him up in a tuxedo outfit and bowtie, so he's part of the show.
- 4. **<u>Signo Transpo</u>**: Two members of the audience sign cards and then their signatures end up on each other's card.
- 5. <u>The Rope Trick</u>: A complex trick which starts with a single piece of rope and is transformed into 3 pieces of rope, then 2 pieces, then turned into a blue piece of string, and then changed back into the single original piece of string.
