

# **BEST NFL RECORDS, PAST 10 YEARS**

#### Sustained excellence.

In the past 10 years, five NFL teams have played at a .600 level or quite close to it -- led by the GREEN BAY PACKERS at a .681 winning percentage. Those teams have combined for 33 playoff and 10 Super Bowl appearances.

In the era of free agency and salary cap restrictions, that consistent performance is impressive.

"It is no coincidence that BRETT FAVRE has started and played in all 160 of those games over the last 10 years," says Packers head coach MIKE SHERMAN. "Also, the Packers have had a good supporting cast that contributed as well. Finally, I believe that there is a certain level of expectation here in Green Bay that demands accountability."
