NOTES ON 2005 NFL TRAVEL

- Eight teams (Atlanta, Arizona, Indianapolis, New York Giants, Oakland, San Diego, San Francisco, and Seattle) will travel around the world at least once. A trip around the globe is 25,000 miles, and each of these teams fly over 26,000 miles.
- **SEATTLE SEAHAWKS** travel the most miles during the season, with seven of their ten road games requiring round trips of over 3,000 miles.
- **NEW YORK GIANTS, OAKLAND RAIDERS,** and **SAN DIEGO CHARGERS** make four cross-country trips. The Chargers and Raiders travel to New England, New York Jets, Philadelphia and Washington; and the Giants to San Diego, Oakland, San Francisco and Seattle.
- **CINCINNATI BENGALS** travel the fewest miles (7,263) and make no trips over 1,400 miles round trip.
- **CHICAGO BEARS** are one of five teams that finish the season with two road games (Buffalo, Detroit, New York Giants and Tennessee). The Bears end the season at division foes Green Bay (373 miles round trip) and Minnesota (702 miles round trip).
- **PHILADELPHIA EAGLES** fly to the fewest games (seven for a total of 15,394 air miles). They take a train to Washington and a bus to the Giants and Ravens.
