2005 NFL PRESEASON INDIVIDUAL & TEAM STATISTICAL LEADERS

NFL preseason statistical leaders were tracked in 2005 by the Elias Sports Bureau, official statisticians of the NFL.

Listed below are the final preseason leaders in the American and National Football Conferences. Baltimore Ravens running back **CHESTER TAYLOR** was the NFL preseason rushing leader (270 yards). Rookie wide receiver **MARK BRADLEY** of the Chicago Bears led the league in receiving yards (331). The leading passer was Denver Broncos quarterback **JAKE PLUMMER** with a 123.6 rating.

The Denver Broncos finished the 2005 preseason with the top-ranked offense, averaging 403.3 yards per game. The N.Y. Giants led the league in defense with a 233.0 yards-per-game average.
