

UPDATED AFC-NFC PLAYOFF SEEDINGS

Attached is an updated version of the AFC-NFC playoff seeding possibilities that was sent yesterday.

It has been determined that if the New York Giants and Carolina tie for the No. 3 seed in the NFC at 11-5, the best Carolina can do is tie New York in strength of victory, which means the tiebreaker would move on to strength of schedule. The Giants have an insurmountable 10-game lead in that tiebreaker. Therefore, New York would be the No. 3 seed and Carolina would be the No. 4 seed in those scenarios.

Also in the scenario whereby New York, Tampa Bay and Dallas tie for the two Wild Card spots at 10-6, Dallas cannot be the No. 5 seed, and will only be the No. 6 if New York is the No. 5 and Dallas defeats Tampa Bay on strength of victory.
