BRYANT'S FIELD GOAL SECOND LONGEST FINAL-PLAY GAME-WINNER

MATT BRYANT's 62-yard field goal with no time left to win today's game for the Tampa Bay Buccaneers 23-21 over the Philadelphia Eagles was the second longest winning field goal on a game's final play in NFL history.

The longest such kick was by New Orleans' **TOM DEMPSEY** for 63 yards on November 8, 1970 to defeat Detroit 19-17.

Bryant's field goal was the third longest in history, after Dempsey's kick, and **JASON ELAM**'s 63-yarder for Denver on October 25, 1998 in a 37-24 victory over Jacksonville.
