## WHAT TO LOOK FOR IN 2007

**JOE GIBBS**, Washington, needs nine victories to pass Bud Grant (168) and Chuck Knox (170) to move into tenth place alltime in career victories (see Holmgren note) and needs five regular-season victories to reach 150. In 15 seasons, Gibbs has 162 career victories and 145 regular- season victories.

**<u>MIKE HOLMGREN</u>**, Seattle, needs 12 victories to pass Bill Cowher (161), Joe Gibbs (162), Bud Grant (168) and Chuck Knox (170) to move into tenth place all-time in career victories (see Gibbs note) and needs three regular-season victories to reach 150. In 15 seasons, Holmgren has 159 career victories and 147 regular-season victories.

<u>MIKE SHANAHAN</u>, Denver, needs 11 victories to reach 150 regular-season victories. In 15 seasons, Shanahan has 139 regular-season victories.

TOM COUGHLIN, New York Giants, needs three victories to reach 100 career victories and seven regular-season victories to reach 100. In 11 seasons, Coughlin has 97 career victories and 93 regular-season victories.

ANDY REID, Philadelphia, needs 12 victories to reach 100 career victories. In eight seasons, Reid has 88 career victories.
