THE UNIVERSITY OF NEBRASKA AT LINCOLN.... HOME TO ONE OF THE MOST PRESTIGIOUS COLLEGE FOOTBALL PROGRAMS IN THE COUNTRY...

IN 2008, THE CORNHUSKERS LEGENDARY FORMER COACH AND CURRENT ATHLETIC DIRECTOR TOM OSBORNE, RECEIVED AN UNUSUAL CALL FROM A BUSINESSMAN IN OMAHA – A MAN WITH A NET WORTH, OF APPROXIMATELY 200 MILLION DOLLARS.

YOU KNOW INITIALLY I WAS LIKE A LITTLE BIT TAKEN BACK BY THE WHOLE THING THINKING HERE THIS GUY IS WHO HAS BEEN IN THE FINANCIAL ARENA AND ALL OF A SUDDEN HE WANTS TO BECOME A COACH AND IT JUST DIDN'T ALL SEEM TO FIT BUT ONCE YOU SIT DOWN WITH JOE AND YOU GET TO KNOW HIM AND YOU REALIZE HIS STORY AND HIS BACKGROUND.

I THINK BACK WHEN I WAS COACHING.

FOR TWO SEASONS NOW, EACH WEEK JOE MOGLIA'S ROUTINE IS THE SAME. HE SPENDS A DAY IN OMAHA, THEN TRAVELS ONE HOUR FROM HOME FOR A WEEK IN LINCOLN.

FOR THIS 61-YEAR-OLD, IT'S JUST ONE MORE TURN, IN AN EXTRAORDINARY LIFE'S JOURNEY.

AND WELCOME TO THIS PROGRAM WHERE WE ARE GOING TO HAVE A CHANCE TO LEARN THE LESSONS OF A REMARKABLE LIFE. WHAT IS THE STORY. HOW DID YOU FINE YOURSELF HERE.

WELL I GREW UP IN THE SECTION OF MANHATTAN. IT'S AN INNER CITY BAD PART OF NY. MY DAD WAS BORN AND RAISED IN ITALY. HE CAME TO THIS COUNTRY WHEN HE WAS 11 AND SOLD FRUITS AND VEGTABLES AND NEITHER WASHINGTON HEIGHTS OR BRONX HIS ENTIRE LIFE AND HE DIDN'T RETIRE UNTIL HE WAS 80. GUY WAS DRINKING AND STEALING AND DOING THINGS HE WASN'T FOR PROBABLY TILL THE TIME I WAS 11. 2 OF MY VERY BEST FRIENDS

FROM GRAMMAR SCHOOL THAT I WAS LITTERALLY WITH EVERY DAY HAD ALREADY DROPPED OUT OF HIGH SCHOOL BUT IN HIGH SCHOOL ONE DIED OF A DRUG OVERDOSE AND THE OTHER ONE WAS KILLED BY THE POLICE ROBBING A LIQUOR STORE. I NEVER DID DRUGS BUT HAVING NOT BEEN PLAYING FOOTBALL THERE IS PROBABLY A CHANCE THAT I WOULD HAVE BEEN WITH THE GUY ROBBING THE LIQUOR STORE.

MOGLIA GRADUATED FROM HIGH SCHOOL AT FORDHAM PREP, AND WAS EXPECTING TO PLAY SPORTS AT FORDHAM UNIVERSITY. // BUT AT AGE 19, HE GOT HIS GIRLFRIEND PREGNANT, AND INSTEAD HE FOCUSED ON BEING A FATHER, AND A HUSBAND.

I AM RESPONSIBLE FOR MY OWN TUITION AND I AM SUPPORTING MY WIFE AND DAUGHTER AND I DROVE A TAXI CAB FOR NY CITY. I DROVE A TRUCK FOR THE POST OFFICE AND THE OTHER TIME I WORKED AT MY DAD'S STORE. NOW AT THE END OF MY FRESHMAN YEAR, AS YOU MIGHT THINK THIS WAS NOT THE MOST FUN I HAVE EVER HAD IN MY LIFE. AND I THOUGHT THAT I WAS GOING TO BLOW MY BRAINS OUT AND WHAT HIT ME IS THAT THIS IS THE FIRST YEAR OF MY LIFE THAT I DIDN'T HAVE SPORTS. SO I WENT BACK TO THE PREP AND ASKED THEM IF THEY WOULD CONSIDER GIVING ME A COACHING JOB AND THEY DID.

AT AGE 22, HE BECAME THE YOUNGEST HIGH SCHOOL FOOTBALL COACH IN THE HISTORY OF THE STATE OF DELAWARE.// AFTER TURNING TWO HIGH SCHOOL PROGRAMS AROUND, HE JOINED THE STAFF OF LAFAYETTE COLLEGE. HIS DEFENSE AND SPECIAL TEAMS UNITS WOULD SET TWO NATIONAL AND 9 SCHOOL RECORDS.// HE THEN BECAME THE DEFENSIVE COORDINATOR AT DARTMOUTH. IN HIS FIRST YEAR THERE, HE GOT DIVORCED.

I DIDN'T HAVE ENOUGH MONEY WHERE I COULD LIVE INDEPENDANTLY
AND TAKE CARE OF 4 CHILDREN AND MY WIFE SO I ENDED UP GETTING
PERMISSION TO MOVE INTO THE STORAGE ROOM ABOVE THE FOOTBALL OFFICE

AT DARMOUTH. THIS LOFT HAD NO HEAT SO I COULD ACTUALLY SEE MY BREATH IN THE LOFT. WELL I DIDN'T MIND THAT SO MUCH BUT I WOUND UP LIVING THERE FOR 2 YEARS.

IN 1984, THE UNIVERSITY OF MIAMI, AFTER DEFEATING TOM OSBORNE'S CORNHUSKERS TO WIN THE NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP, OFFERED MOGLIA AN OPPORTUNITY TO BE THEIR DEFENSIVE COORDINATOR.

PROBABLY THE TOUGHEST CAREER DECISION I EVER MADE IN MY LIFE WAS THIKING HARD ABOUT THAT ONE BUT AFTER ABOUT 48 HOURS I CALLED THEM BACK AND SAID I CAN'T TAKE THE JOB AND I DIDN'T KNOW HOW I COULD LIVE IN CORAL CABLES FLORIDA, COACH FOOTBALL, MY KIDS WOULD BE 1000 MILES AWAY, I WOULDN'T HAVE ENOUGH MONEY TO SIMPLY FLY BACK AND FORTH AND I DIDN'T KNOW HOW I COULD DO A GOOD JOB AS A COACH AS I COULD LIVE UP TO MY RESPONSIBLITIES SO I TURNED THE JOB DOWN.

FALLING BACK ON HIS UNDERGRADUATE DEGREE IN ECONOMICS, MOGLIA HEADED TO WALL STREET. HE CONVINCED AN INVESTMENT BANK THAT USUALLY HIRED IVY LEAGUE MBA'S, TO TAKE A CHANCE, ON A 34-YEAR-OLD FOOTBALL COACH.

WHAT I KNOW ABOUT FINANCIAL SECTOR I DIDN'T KNOW SQUAT AND I DIDN'T KNOW HOW TO SPELL BOND AND I DIDN'T KNOW HOW TO SPELL STOCK AND I HAD NO BACKGROUND AT ALL COMPARED TO THE HARVARD AND STANFORD ETC. MBA'S. I DIDN'T HAVE THAT BUT I HAD GONE THROUGH A WHOLE LIFE THAT NONE OF THEM HAD.

THE SAME TRAITS THAT HELPED HIM THRIVE IN THE FOOTBALL WORLD SET HIM APART IN THE BUSINESS WORLD. HE BECAME THE TOP BOND SALESMAN IN THE WORLD. IN 2001, AN ONLINE FINANCIAL COMPANY IN OMAHA, SELECTED HIM TO BE ITS CEO.

HE CAME IN WHEN A TIME WHERE WE WERE TEETERING AS A COMPANY BUT ULTIMATELY THE COMPANY THAT WE ARE TODAY AND THE LEADER OF ONLINE TRADER IN THE WORLD IS A DIRECT ATRIBUTE TO JOE AND CERTAINLY THE REST OF THE TEAM.

IF WE HAD BEEN A COLLEGE FOOTBALL TEAM WE LITTERLY WOULD HAVE WON A COUPLE NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS BUT IT WOULD NOT HAVE BEEN NEBRASKA OR NOTRE DAME OR THE USC. IT WOULD HAVE BEEN LIKE A LAKE FOREST.

IN 2008, MOGLIA STEPPED DOWN AS CEO OF TD AMERITRADE.

SO I THOUGHT THAT IN THIS POINT OF MY LIFE WHEN I COULD PROBABLY DO A LOT OF THINGS WHAT WOULD BE THE THING THAT I COULD DO THAT WOULD GIVE ME THE GREATEST IMPACT AND THE THING THAT I CAN GET THE GREATEST STATISFACTION OF. I THOUGHT GOING BACK TO FOOTBALL AS A HEAD COACH WAS IT. IT DOESN'T HAVE TO BE A COLLEGE HEAD COACHING JOB BUT THE REASON WHY THE COLLEGE HEAD COACHING JOB WAS THE FIRST JOB THAT I THOUGHT ABOUT WAS BECAUSE HELPING AN 18 TO 22 YEAR OLD BOY BECOME A MAN. THAT REALLY GENUINELY MEANS SOMETHING SPECIAL TO ME.

MOGLIA STILL HAS AN OFFICE IN OMAHA AS CHAIRMAN OF TD AMERITRADE.// BUT TO MAKE HIMSELF INTO A VIABLE HEAD COACHING CANDIDATE, HE SPENDS MOST DAYS IN THE NEBRASKA FOOTBALL DEPARTMENT, IN A ROOM WITH TWO GRADUATE ASSISTANTS.

HE IS UNPAID BUT GETS A FIRSTHAND TUTORIAL IN THE BUILDING OF A NATIONAL POWERHOUSE.

HOW DO YOU DEIFERIATE BETWEEN THE BELLY SWIPE AND THE CROSS FIRE?

AND IN TURN, HE PROVIDES LIFE GUIDANCE TO THE PLAYERS....

I THINK IT IS REALLY CRITICAL THAT YOU GOT A PLAN IN TERMS OF WHAT YOU ULTIMATELY WANT TO DO.

OR ANYONE WHO ASKS FOR IT.

I HAVE AN EMPHASIS ON FINANCE, ENERGY.

HE HAS SURPRISED EVERYONE WITH HIS LEVEL OF COMMITMENT AND I THINK HE SPENT SEVERAL 1000 HOURS HERE TO GET HIMSELF UP TO SPEED IN TERMS OF X'S AND O'S. AND HE HAS BEEN AT ALL THE MEETINGS AND ALL THE PRACTICES. LIVED IN A HOTEL HERE IN LINCOLN FOR PROBABLY 180-200 NIGHTS.

I THINK THAT IN SOME POINT OVER THE SPAND OF 3 MONTHS I KINDA WENT FROM I BELIEVE WHO IS THIS GUY TO HE IS A COACH KINDA GOING BACK TO COACHING AND WE CAN TRUST HIM AND HE IS A GOOD GUY AND WE ARE KINDA HAPPY HE IS AROUND AS OPPOSED TO NOT.

THANKS DJ. TO APPRECIATE THE OPPORTUNTIY THAT I HAVE BEEN GIVEN IN NEBRASKA YOU REALLY HAVE TO UNDERSTAND WHAT GOES ON IN A COACHES LIFE. IT'S AN INCREDIBLY INTENSE STRESSFUL ENVIRONMENT. YOU DON'T BRING A STRANGER INTO THAT ENVIRONMENT. BO PALINNY DID THAT FOR ME AT NEBRASKA AND I JUST CAN'T TELL YOU HOW APPRECIATIVE I AM.
