BASEBALL HAS THE LEGEND OF WALLY PIPP, THE YANKEES FIRST BASEMAN WHO SAT OUT ONE GAME WITH A HEADACHE ONLY TO BE REPLACED BY THE SPORTS IRON HORSE, LOU GEHRIG.

THE NFL HAS IT'S OWN WALLY PIPP.

RADIO – OH MAJKOWSKI'S IN GREAT PAIN. I THINK THAT MIGHT BE IT FOR HIM TODAY, AND IN COMES BRETT FAVRE.

MAJKOWSKI WAS AN ESCAPE ARTIST FROM DAY ONE, BUT IT WAS THE 1989 SEASON THAT WAS PURE MAGIC.

RADIO – HERE'S MAJKOWSKI. GUY BREAKING DOWN ON HIM OVER THE MIDDLE! CAUGHT BY SHARPE!

SHARPE – HE GAVE ME THE ABILITY TO FEEL LIKE I COULD ALMOST WALK ON WATER LIKE HE COULD.

WE COULD BE DOWN 2 TOUCHDOWNS WITH 4 MINS. LEFT, AND I NEVER DOUBTED THAT WE WERE GONNA PULL IT OUT.

RADIO - WHAT A PLAY BY MAJKOWSKI.

HE DID MAKE US BELIEVE IN MAGIC.

RADIO – ON 4TH & GOAL FROM THE 14; MAJKOWSKI'S LOOKING. NOW STEPPING UP, ON THE RUN. HE'S GONNA HAVE TO THROW IN THE END ZONE. TOUCHDOWN! STERLING SHARPE!

WHEN YOU'RE IN YOUR 3RD YEAR, YOU'RE LEADING THE LEAGUE IN PASSING AND YOU MAKE ALL PRO. YOU AUTOMATICALLY HAVE A BELIEF IN YOURSELF THAT I CAN BE ONE OF THE TOP QBS IN THIS LEAGUE.

AND IN 1992, EVEN WITH THE ARRIVAL OF BRETT FAVRE, THAT DIDN'T CHANGE.

BECAUSE HE WAS OUR GUY. AND THEN WE GOT BRETT FAVRE WHO WAS LIKE RAW.....REALLY RAW. AND UNDER PRACTICED. AND I'M GOING, "OH MY GOD. OH MY GOD, HERE WE GO."

RADIO – ALRIGHT. WELL YOU GOT A MINUTE 7. YOU STILL GOT A CHANCE. IF YOU SCORE A TD. AND AN EXTRA POINT YOU COULD WIN IT.

WHAT FOLLOWED WAS THE BIRTH OF ONE CAREER AND, IN A SENSE, THE END OF ANOTHER.

RADIO – WIDE OPEN. TOUCHDOWN! AND IT'S CAUGHT BY ... AND IT IS KEDRICK TAYLOR! I CAN'T BELIEVE IT, JIM. A GREAT PASS BY FAVRE.

I WAS IN THE L.R. IN THE STADIUM. I WAS SITTING THERE WITH ICE ON MY ANKLE; AND WHEN HE CAUGHT THAT TD. PASS, UNDERNEATH THE STADIUM YOU COULD HEAR THIS EXPLOSION. THIS ROAR THAT SOMETHING UNBELIEVABLE HAPPENED.

RADIO – AND THE PACKERS WIN IT 24-23! HOW ABOUT THAT?! GOOD EVENING EVERYONE. HISTORY TONIGHT. QB, BRETT FAVRE, STARTS HIS 200TH CONSECUTIVE GAME.

IN FACT, FAVRE STARTED THE NEXT 253 GAMES WITH THE PACKERS AND BECAME FOOTBALL'S LOU GEHRIG.

GRUDEN – ALL OF A SUDDEN, YOU BECOME THAT PLAYER THAT, WHAT DO YOU DO? YOU LIMP AROUND ON CRUTCHES. YOU'RE NO LONGER A PART OF THE TEAM.

FAVRE'S IRONMAN STREAK MADE THE MAJIK MAN DISAPPEAR. MAJKOWSKI BECAME A TRIVIA QUESTION. "WHO WAS THE LAST QUARTERBACK TO START FOR THE PACKERS BEFORE FAVRE?"

THIS IS A PICTURE OF MY SON, BO. WE DRESSED HIM UP FOR HALLOWEEN WHEN HE WAS ABOUT A YEAR.

SO WE DECIDED WE WERE GONNA GET A DON MAJKOWSKI OUTFIT. WELL THERE WEREN'T ANY.

IT WAS INITIALLY A #4 JERSEY. SO WE HAD TO KIND OF CAMOUFLAGE OR SPRAY PAINT OVER THE #4 AND PAINT A #7 OVER IT.

EIGHTEEN YEARS LATER, THE ANKLE THAT LAUNCHED FAVRE'S CAREER HAS YET TO FULLY HEAL.

I'VE HAD 11 SURGERIES POST-PLAYING CAREER. THAT ANKLE INJURY THAT I SUFFERED IN 1992, EVENTUALLY LED TO A VERY SERIOUS ANKLE CONDITION.

FOR A YEAR HE TRIED TO WALK ON IT, BONE-ON-BONE. HE REALLY SPENT PROBABLY 70 TO 80% OF THE DAY IN BED. HE SAID, "I WANT TO TALK TO A DOCTOR ABOUT AMPUTATION."

I WAS PRETTY MISERABLE FOR A LOT OF YEARS. SO, I'M FINALLY HEALED-UP A LITTLE BIT NOW. I HAD SOME GREAT SURGERY.

WHAT WE DID WAS WE PUT THESE 2 PLATES THAT HELD THE 2 BONES TOGETHER AND PUT MULTIPLE SCREWS, AS YOU CAN SEE.

HAVING MY ANKLE FUSED WITH 13 SCREWS AND 2 TITANIUM PLATES, AND BACK ON TRACK TO ENJOY MYSELF AGAIN AND HAVING THE PERSONALITY THAT I'M USED TO HAVING.

THE MAJIK MAN IS BACK TO HIS OLD TRICKS AND HE'S NOT THE ONLY ONE. MAJKOWSKI'S BEEN COACHING HIS SON BO ON A YOUTH FOOTBALL TEAM.

I TRY TO TEACH HIM ALL THE INS AND OUTS THAT I WISH SOMEBODY WOULD'VE TAUGHT ME WHEN I WAS YOUNGER.

WHEN I SIT IN THE STANDS AND I LOOK AT BO, AND I SEE HIM DROP BACK, HE LOOKS LIKE A MINI-DON.

WHAT DID YA LOSE A TOOTH? NO. JUST COUGHED UP BLOOD.

I LIKE THAT MAN.

I WISH HE COULD GO OUT AND COACH COLLEGE AGE KIDS BUT HE CHOSE TO NOT GO THERE, EVEN THOUGH I KNOW IT WOULD REALLY MAKE HIM HAPPY TO BE WITH BO. SO I ADMIRE HIM FOR THAT.

MAJKOWSKI IS NOW A SUCCESSFUL REAL ESTATE INVESTOR AND HAS BECOME A PARTNER OF A WEBSITE FOR HIGH SCHOOL SPORTS, BUT IS THE FORMER PACKER QUARTERBACK DESTINED TO BE REMEMBERED AS THE WALLY PIPP OF THE NFL?

SHARPE – HE HAD THE ABILITY. HE HAD THE SKILL-SET. HE HAD THE MOXIE. HE HAD THE SWAGGER. IF HIS BODY WOULD'VE HELD UP, AND IF HE DIDN'T PLAY WITH SUCH RECKLESS ABANDONED, WE MAY HAVE NEVER HEARD OF BRETT FAVRE.

WHEN I GO BACK THERE FOR A GAME, TO THIS DAY, THEY DIDN'T FORGET A THING, AND THEY STILL APPRECIATED EVERYTHING YOU DID FOR THEM DURING THOSE TIMES WHERE WE BROUGHT BACK SOME EXCITEMENT TO PACKER NATION.
