WHEN BEARS QUARTERBACK JAY CUTLER LEFT THE FIELD JUST BEFORE HALFTIME, HIS RETURN WAS QUESTIONABLE BECAUSE OF A KNEE INJURY. IN THE SECOND HALF, HE CAME BACK FOR ONE SERIES, AND THEN WATCHED THE BEARS <u>DEFENSE</u> PROVIDE THE SPARK CHICAGO NEEDED.

(TILLMAN - "C'MON TODD, HELP US OUT BABY")

BACKUP TODD COLLINS <u>DIDN'T</u> HELP. HE WENT 0-FOR-4 PASSING, AND FAILED TO GENERATE A FIRST DOWN IN TWO SERIES.

("IF CUTLER DOESN'T COME BACK IN, BEARS ARE GONNA LOSE GAME")

CUTLER <u>DIDN'T</u> COME BACK IN ON THE BEARS NEXT SERIES, AND NEITHER DID TODD COLLINS. / INSTEAD IT WAS THIRD STRINGER CALEB HANIE, WHO BEFORE SUNDAY HAD COMPLETED JUST EIGHT CAREER PASSES IN THREE NFL SEASONS.

ON HIS FIRST SERIES, THE FORMER UNDRAFTED FREE AGENT OUT OF COLORADO STATE GUIDED CHICAGO 67 YARDS IN EIGHT PLAYS.

(BENCH SOUND – "ONE SCORE GAME, EVERYTHING YOU GOT")
DOWN 14-7 IN THE FOURTH QUARTER, HANIE'S INEXPERIENCE FINALLY SEEMED TO SEAL HIS TEAM'S FATE.

(RADIO - RAJI TD; "LET'S FINISH EM OFF")

LEADING 21 TO 7 WITH UNDER FIVE MINUTES REMAINING, THE PACKERS <u>COULDN'T</u> FINISH OFF HANIE OR THE BEARS.

(RADIO - BENNETT TD; "IT HAS TO BE DRAMATIC")

AND ALL THE DRAMA WAS BEING PROVIDED BY A SEEMINGLY UNFAZED THIRD STRINGER. // IN THE FINAL MINUTES, CHICAGO WAS DOWN 21 TO 14. // AND CALEB HANIE AND THE BEARS WERE MAKING ONE FINAL PUSH TOWARD THE UNLIKELIEST OF COMEBACKS.

(RADIO – FINAL INT.)

IN THE 182ND, AND MOST IMPORTANT, MEETING BETWEEN THE NFL'S OLDEST RIVALS, THE PACKERS WERE THE ONES LEFT STANDING. / NOW THE TEAM FROM TITLE TOWN IS ONE WIN AWAY FROM A FOURTH LOMBARDI TROPHY.

NEW YORK JETS @ PITTSBURGH STEELERS - PART 1

NEW YORK'S CONFIDENCE WAS SHAKEN AFTER THE STEELERS OPENED THE GAME WITH A 15-PLAY SCORING DRIVE THAT CONSUMED MORE THAN NINE MINUTES.

PITTSBURGH CONTINUED TO POUND THE JETS, FINDING HOLES IN AN UNCHARACTERISTICALLY SUSPECT DEFENSE.

THE STEELERS RUSHED FOR 135 YARDS IN THE FIRST HALF, INCLUDING 95 FROM RASHARD MENDENHALL.

NEW YORK ALSO STRUGGLED TO CONTAIN BEN ROETHLISBER. BIG BEN TORMENTED THE JETS WITH HIS ELUSIVENESS AND HIS ABILITY TO CONVERT THIRD DOWNS.

ROETHLISBERGER'S LEGS GAVE THE STEELERS A 17-0 LEAD.

IN THEIR WEEK 15 VICTORY IN PITTSBURGH, THE JETS HAD SUCCESS WITH A BALANCED ATTACK. ON SUNDAY, THEY WERE HELD TO 50 TOTAL YARDS IN THE FIRST HALF.

TRAILING 24-3, THE JETS BIG-PLAY OFFENSE FINALLY SHOWED UP.

THE JETS GAINED NEARLY AS MANY YARDS ON SANTONIO HOLMES'S TOUCHDOWN AS THEY HAD THE ENTIRE FIRST HALF.

THE JETS BEGAN THE FOURTH QUARTER WITH THEIR BEST DRIVE OF THE GAME. //
STILL LEADING BY TWO TOUCHDOWNS, PITTSBURGH'S DEFENSE TRIED TO KEEP
EVERYTHING IN FRONT OF THEM. THE JETS DIDN'T CARE WHAT WAS IN FRONT OF
THEM. // THE DRIVE CONSUMED NEARLY 8 MINUTES, AND LED TO A 4TH AND GOAL AT
THE ONE YARD LINE.

THE JETS GOT ONE ON THEIR NEXT POSSESSION.

CONVENTIONAL WISDOM SAYS YOU RUN OUT THE CLOCK BY RUNNING THE BALL. BUT WHEN THE CHIPS ARE DOWN, THE STEELERS USUALLY BET ON THEIR LUCKY NUMBER SEVEN.

A 3RD AND 6 AT THE TWO MINUTE WARNING DIDN'T SEEM LIKE THE TIME TO GAMBLE AND ROLL SNAKE EYES.

ALT: IT DIDN'T SEEM LIKE THE TIME TO ROLL THE DICE, ON $3^{\rm RD}$ AND 6 AT THE TWO MINUTE WARNING.
