SPRING OF 2011. FOR TOM ZBIKOWSKI IT WAS, APPROPRIATELY, A REBIRTH. A PASSION THAT ONCE BURNED BRIGHTLY, WAS KINDLED ONCE AGAIN.

BOXING YOU HAVE ALL THE FREEDOM IN THE WORLD. IT'S UPON YOUR SHOULDERS IF YOU GET KNOCKED OUT OR NOT. YOU HAVE THAT 100% FREEDOM, KIND OF DO YOUR OWN THING.

TOM ZBIKOWSKI'S LOVE OF BOXING DATES BACK TO CHILDHOOD, WHEN HIS OLDER BROTHER, E.J., FACED A FIGHT OF HIS OWN.

WHEN HE WAS ABOUT 4, 3 OR 4 HE STARTED TO HAVE SEIZURES, AND WE DIDN'T KNOW WHAT IT WAS AND WE WENT THROUGH A LONG PROCESS OF TRYING TO FIND OUT WHAT WAS WRONG.

THAT WAS REALLY DEVASTATING AND YOU REALLY APPROACH LIFE A LOT DIFFERENTLY AFTER YOU HAVE SOMETHING LIKE THAT IN YOUR LIFE.

THE ZBIKOWSKI'S HAD LOST THEIR FIRST SON, STEPHEN, IN INFANCY SIX YEARS EARLIER. THEY WERE RELIEVED WHEN DOCTORS SUCCESSFULLY REMOVED A BENIGN TUMOR FROM E.J. BUT THREE YEARS LATER, THE SEIZURES RETURNED.

HE USED TO BE PITCHING AT BASEBALL GAMES HAVING SEIZURES AND YOU STILL COULDN'T PULL HIM OFF THE BASEBALL FIELD. HE DIDN'T MISS A BEAT. HE DIDN'T BUDGE, AND HE WAS JUST MY BIGGEST INFLUENCE.

WE HAD MET ANOTHER COUPLE WHEN WE WERE AT MAYO CLINIC, AND THEY LIVED IN FLORIDA.

THE ZBIKOWSKI'S VISITED THIS FAMILY WHOSE DAUGHTER, REBECCA, HAD A SIMILAR CONDITION TO E.J. REBECCA'S FATHER, HAROLD "HACKY" REITMAN, WAS A PROFESSIONAL BOXER.

HACKY WOULD TAKE HIM IN THE BOXING RING AND HE'S SPAR WITH HIM, AND THEN THEY'D FIGHT EACH OTHER. E.J. AND TOMMY WOULD FIGHT EACH OTHER AND THEY WOULD HAVE A GREAT TIME DOING THAT.

THAT'S THE FIRST TIME IN THE GYM AND KIND OF FELL IN LOVE WITH IT JUST RIGHT AWAY. // I WAS JUST A HYPERACTIVE KID. SO THEY TRIED TO PUT ME IN SOCCER WHEN I WAS LIKE 4. I GOT KICKED OUT OF THAT, AND IT WAS ONTO BASEBALL. THEN IT WENT TO WRESTLING. AND THOSE ONE-ON-ONE SPORTS JUST ALWAYS HAD MY ATTENTION. YOU HAVE TO BE FOCUSED THE WHOLE TIME. IT'S THE ONLY THING WHERE IT'S JUST COMPLETELY CALM TO ME.

SO THAT STARTED THE WHOLE THING AND MEDICINE BALLS AND SIT-UPS, AND LEARNING HOW TO HIT THE BAG AND ALL THAT, AND HE REALLY LIKED IT, UNFORTUNATELY.

BUT I KNOW IT HAD TO BE HARD FOR HER WITH THE LOSS AND ALMOST LOSING ANOTHER CHILD. IT HAD TO BE DIFFICULT BUT MY DAD AND MY BROTHER MADE A DEAL WITH MY MOM WHERE AS SOON AS HE GETS KNOCKED DOWN OR KNOCKED OUT, HE'S DONE WITH BOXING.

WELL, THAT NEVER HAPPENED SO HERE IT GOES ON FOR 85, 90 FIGHTS OR SO AND HE NEVER GOT KNOCKED OUT.

THERE WERE LIKE 54 GYMS IN CHICAGO. WE WERE LIKE GYPSIES. WHEN WE WOULD LEARN EVERYTHING IN THAT GYM, WE'D GO TO ANOTHER GYM. HIS BOXING MATURITY CAME AT A VERY VERY YOUNG AGE.

ZBIKOWSKI RACKED UP OVER 70 AMATEUR BOUTS BY HIS EARLY TEENS, MEETING BOXING LEGENDS ACROSS THE COUNTRY ALONG THE WAY. AND FIGHTING MANY OF THE NATION'S BEST.

I BELIEVE THAT TOMMY COULD'VE BEEN THE U.S. OLYMPIC REPRESENTATIVE AT THE HEAVYWEIGHT TOURNAMENT 1 LB. DIVISION IN 2004. I KNOW THIS FOR A FACT BECAUSE I MANAGED THE OLYMPIC REPRESENTATIVE, DEVIN VARGAS; AND I KNOW TOMMY WOULD HAVE HANDLED HIM

IN 2006, TOM MADE HIS PROFESSIONAL BOXING DEBUT IN SPECTACULAR FASHION.

BUT THIS IS NOT A STORY OF BOY TURNS CHAMPION. TOM ZBIKOWSKI WAS NOT A ONE-SPORT MAN.

PEOPLE DON'T UNDERSTAND THAT TOMMY'S BOXED AND PLAYED FOOTBALL HIS ENTIRE LIFE. THE 2 HAVE ALWAYS MESHED AND HE'S PUT IN THE TIME IN BOTH.

BY HIS LATE TEENS, TOM TURNED TO FOOTBALL, FULFILLING A CHILDHOOD DREAM BY PLAYING AT NOTRE DAME.

TWO YEARS AFTER HIS PRO BOXING DEBUT, TOM WAS DRAFTED BY THE BALTIMORE RAVENS, LEAVING LITTLE ROOM FOR BOXING.

RADIO – TOM ZBIKOWSKI COMING UP WITH THE INTERCEPTION.

BOXING KIND OF JUST WENT TO THE WAYSIDE. I HAD TO MAKE THE RIGHT DECISION. FIGURE OUT WHAT WAS BEST FOR ME.

THAT CHANGED IN 2011. THE NFL WORK STOPPAGE ALLOWED ZBIKOWSKI TO RESUME HIS BOXING CAREER.

5 YRS. IS A LONG TIME TO TAKE OFF FROM A SPORT, FROM ANY SPORT, ESPECIALLY FROM BOXING. AND I DIDN'T THINK I'D HAVE THE OPPORTUNITY TO FIGHT. NOT DURING MY FOOTBALL CAREER.

WE'VE HAD A LOT OF CONVERSATIONS ABOUT HIS BOXING CAREER AND WHAT HE WANTED TO DO WITH IT. HE'S NOT GONNA GIVE THAT UP. THAT MIGHT BE SOMETHING HE DOES UNTIL HIS ARMS FALL OFF. I THINK HE'S GONNA BE BOXING FOR A LONG TIME.

WHAT I'VE WANTED TO GET DONE IS GET THROUGH A FULL ROUND FIGHT; KNOW WHAT IT FEELS LIKE AGAIN. JUST GAIN THE EXPERIENCE AND GETTING MYSELF IN BETTER SHAPE FOR FOOTBALL BUT KNOWING THAT I STILL HAVE THAT ABILITY IF NEED BE BECAUSE YOU NEVER KNOW WHEN YOUR LAST PLAY'S GONNA BE IN FOOTBALL.

TOM IS FOREVER AWARE THAT OPPORTUNITY IS FLEETING.

I THINK A LOT OF TOMMY'S BOXING DRIVE COMES FROM THE FACT OF E.J. OVERCOMING SUCH A SEVERE ILLNESS AT AN EARLY AGE, AND SERVE AS HIS INSPIRATION.

THAT'S THE MOST IMPORTANT PERSON IN MY LIFE BY FAR. WHEN HE FACED DEATH AND JUST SMILED AT IT. I NEVER HAD TO DO THAT. I NEVER EVEN CAME CLOSE TO THAT. I BOX AND PLAY FOOTBALL A LITTLE BIT. HE JUST STARED AT IT, LAUGHED, AND KEPT MOVING ON.

SO IT'S FITTING THAT, IN HIS FINAL FIGHT OF 2011, TOM IS LED TO THE RING BY HIS BIG BROTHER, E.J.

FOOTBALL PLAYERS HAVE BEEN, FOR THE MOST PART, HORRIFYINGLY BAD IN BOXING. YES. TOMMY Z. WOULD LIKE TO CHANGE THAT REPUTATION. WITH THE SITUATION...OH, WHAT A SHOT. TEDDY NUGENT PUNCHED ...RIGHT UPPER CUT.

FINISH IT! LET'S GO! FINISH IT!

THERE'S THAT HOOK AGAIN, AND THE END IS NEAR. ANOTHER ONE, AND DOWN HE GOES. THAT'S IT.

I REALLY WANT TO BE ON THE S.B. TEAM BUT ALSO TO BE ABLE TO SEE A BELT, AND BE ABLE TO HOLD A BELT UP AND BE WORLD CHAMP. THERE'S NOT TOO MANY GUYS THAT CAN SAY THAT. YOU GET TO KEEP THAT THING THE REST OF YOUR LIFE.
