THE YOUNGEST OF GEORGIA WOODSON'S THREE CHILDREN HAD AN OBVIOUS FLAW. HE WAS BORN WITH CLUBBED FEET AND HAD TO WEAR CORRECTIVE SHOES.

HE SLEPT IN THEM. WE WENT TO CHURCH IN THEM. EVERYWHERE THAT WE HAD TO GO HE HAD TO WEAR THOSE SHOES, AND IT TROUBLED HIM SO BAD.

I COULDN'T SEE MYSELF PLAYING IN GREEN BAY. I JUST, I COULDN'T SEE IT. I DIDN'T WANT TO SEE IT. WHEN EVERYBODY WOULD ASK ME, "HEY, WHAT ARE YOU GONNA DO? I HEARD YOU'RE GONNA PLAY IN G.B." NO, I'M NOT. I'M NOT GOING TO G.B. IT'S NOT HAPPENING."

CHARLES WOODSON HAD NO CHOICE. HE ARRIVED IN GREEN BAY BITTER BECAUSE NO OTHER TEAM WANTED HIM.

A COUPLE TIMES HE SNAPPED ON SOME GUYS IN THE TRAINING ROOM, MYSELF INCLUDED, WHICH KIND OF TOOK US ABACK LIKE "WHOA, JUST MESSING AROUND HERE O.K.? JUST HAVING SOME FUN." RADIO – CHARLES WOODSON BREAKING FREE ON THE BLITZ. ..SANTANA MOSS, AND HE'S CUT DOWN NICELY. FUMBLED TH FOOTBALL! SCOOPED UP BY WOODSON! // TO THE 20! 15! 10! 5! TOUCHDOWN, CHARLES WOODSON!

OPPORTUNITIES JUST KEPT COMING, KEPT COMING. AND THEN IT GOT TO A POINT WHERE EVERY WEEK I FELT LIKE I WAS GONNA GET AN INTERCEPTION. I WAS IN HEAVEN.
