New York Giants @ Green Bay Packers

THE PACKERS DID SPEND SOME TIME THROWING ELI MANNING TO THE GROUND.

BUT MOST OF WHAT AARON RODGERS TOSSED UP FELL TO THE TURF AS WELL.

Houston Texans @ Baltimore Ravens

IN THEIR SECOND PLAYOFF GAME IN FRANCHISE HISTORY, THE HOUSTON TEXANS WOULD HAVE TO DEFEAT A TEAM THEY HAD NEVER BEATEN BEFORE, THE BALTIMORE RAVENS.

HOUSTON SEEMED NOT READY FOR PLAYOFF INTENSITY AND MADE A BONEHEAD PLAY THAT USUALLY RELEGATES TEAMS TO THE BONEYARD.

TRAILING 17-6 IN THE SECOND QUARTER, THE TEXANS TURNED TO THEIR WORK HORSE, ARIAN FOSTER, WHO RUSHED FOR 132 YARDS.

IN THE LAST 45 MINUTES, BALTIMORE ONLY MANAGED THREE POINTS AS HOUSTON HELD RAY RICE TO JUST 60 YARDS AND SACKED JOE FLACCO FIVE TIMES.

EVEN WHEN THE RAVENS CAUGHT A SPARK // THE TEXANS SNUFFED OUT THE FLAMES.

ALTHOUGH HOUSTON DOMINATED THE GAME, ROOKIE QUARTERBACK T.J. YATES IN ONLY HIS SEVENTH START WAS NO MATCH FOR THE SEASONED RAVENS DEFENSE.

Denver Broncos @ New England Patriots

TEBOW-MANIA HAS OVERSHADOWED EVERYTHING. // EVEN TOM BRADY SEEMED LIKE A FORGOTTEN MAN. // BUT IN PLAYOFF GAMES LIKE THIS, PRAYERS CAN GO UNANSWERED AND DREAMS CAN FALL HARD.

THE PATRIOTS HAD FALLEN IN THEIR LAST THREE POST SEASON GAMES ARE WERE DETERMINED TO START FAST. THEY SURPRISED THE BRONCOS WITH A NO-HUDDLE OFFENSE THAT FEATURED TIGHTEND AARON HERNANDEZ AS A RUNNING BACK.
