TODAY, QBS WILL AVOID CONTACT AT EVERY POSSIBLE TURN.

BRETT FAVRE WAS A GUY WHO LOVED TO THROW BLOCKS AND WOULD REALLY PUT HIS BODY INTO IT. HE WAS A BIG, PHYSICAL, THICK-SHOULDERED GUY. NOT FRAIL AT ALL; AND YOU ALMOST GOT THE FEELING THAT HE WOULD PREFER TO BE A SAFETY OR A LINEBACKER.

RADIO – HE'S LIKE A PULLING GUARD BUT HE'S NOT JUST OUT THERE FOR SOME WINDOW DRESSING. HE'S LOOKING FOR SOMEONE TO HIT.

TRENT GREEN, I'LL TELL YOU WHAT. AT THE END OF THE DAY THAT WAS ONE QB THAT WOULD STICK HIS SHOULDERS OUT ON THE LINE FOR HIS R.B. WHEN TRENT HANDS-OFF THE BALL, I'M RUNNING TO MY RIGHT. HE BOOTS OFF TO THE LEFT. HE KNOWS IN ABOUT 5 SECS. I WAS GONNA END UP CUTTING AGAINST THE GRAIN AND GOING BACK LEFT. IT WAS EVEN A QUARTERBACK BLOCK...SORT OF, THAT SPRUNG MARSHAWN LYNCH ON ONE OF THE GREATEST RUNS IN NFL HISTORY.

RADIO – HE'S DOWN TO THE 20! 15! HE COULD GO! HE'S GONNA GO! TOUCHDOWN SEAHAWKS!!

EVERYBODY ON OFFENSE BLOCKS. THE WIDE RECEIVERS, THE RBS, THE LINE, EVERYBODY EXCEPT THE QB. SO WHEN YOU'RE ASKED TO DO IT, WHEN YOU HAVE THAT CHANCE YOU HAVE TO CAPITALIZE ON IT.

O.K., WE HAVE TIME FOR A COUPLE MORE QUESTIONS HERE.

HELLO MADONNA. THE N.Y. GIANTS HAVE A PLAYER NAMED VICTOR CRUZ WHO CELEBRATES BY DANCING SALSA IN THE END ZONE. HAVE YOU SEEN HIM? DO YOU HAVE ANY CRITICISM ON HIS MOVES? I HAVE ABSOLUTELY NO CRITICISM. IN FACT, HE'S INSPIRED ME. I'VE BEEN PRACTICING MY SALSA MOVES AND I'M GONNA SHOW THEM TO YOU AND YOU TELL ME WHAT YOU THINK OF THEM? O.K. I DON'T KNOW. I GUESS AT THIS POINT COMING IN HE PROBABLY DIDN'T THINK I WAS GONNA BE MUCH OF A FACTOR.

OH, THAT'S RIGHT. ALRIGHT.

RADIO – WHERE THE I-BACK BEHIND SORGY WHO DROPS BACK TO THROW. LOBS ONE DOWN THE LEFT SIDELINE AND IT IS CAUGHT WITH 1 HAND BY VICTOR CRUZ AND HE'LL GO THE DISTANCE!!

THAT'S A HELL OF A PLAY BY THAT KID.

RADIO – TAKES THE SNAP. DROPS BACK. LOBS ONE END ZONE. IT'S CAUGHT! TOUCHDOWN! AND AGAIN IT'S VICTOR CRUZ.

HEY. I DON'T KNOW WHO #3 IS BUT HOLY... I'M TELLING YOU.

LEBRON JAMES TWEETED ABOUT YOU AFTER THAT JET GAME.

YEA. WELL THE ENTIRE TWITTER NATION WAS BLOWING UP LIKE TWITTER AT THE TIME. SO IT WAS KIND OF ONE OF THOSE THINGS WHERE I KNEW I HAD THE TALENT. I KNEW I COULD DO ALL THOSE THINGS THAT ALL THE OTHER GUYS CAN. IT WAS JUST A MATTER OF GETTING MY OPPORTUNITY.

CRUZ WOULD HAVE TO WAIT FOR HIS CHANCE. AN INJURY KEPT HIM OFF THE FIELD IN 2010. IN 2011, HIS REGULAR SEASON DEBUT WASN'T SO MEMORABLE.

RADIO – CRUZ IN THE SLOT LEFT. MANNING BACK TO THROW. ZIPS ONE LEFT. CAUGHT BY CRUZ. RUNS OUT OF A TACKLE TO THE 40, UP TO MIDFIELD. MAKES ANOTHER MAN MISS AT THE 45. DOWN...!

ALRIGHT. SO NOW WHEN DO YOU THINK, "OH MY GOD, I GOTTA DO THIS DANCE"?

IT WAS PROBABLY AROUND THE 5 YD. LINE WHEN I'M RUNNING IN THERE. AND THEN I GET IN THERE. I'M LOOKING UP AT THE CROWD AND THEY LIKE...THEY WERE SO MAD. THEY WERE SO MAD AT ME. AND THEN I WAS LIKE, "YEA, I GOTTA MAKE THEM EVEN MADDER AND DO THIS DANCE."

RADIO - AND HE DOES A LITTLE SHIMMY TO FINISH IT OFF."

AND THEN IT JUST STEAMROLLED FROM THERE.

WHY'D YOU DO IT AGAIN? YOU SAID YOUR GRANDMOTHER LIKED IT THE FIRST TIME?

YEA. SHE LIKED IT THE FIRST TIME. I GUESS SHE GOT A BUNCH OF PHONE CALLS THE FIRST TIME. IT WAS LIKE, "OH MY GOSH, SHE'S CALLING ME." AND SHE'S LIKE, "YOU GOTTA KEEP DOING IT. YOU CAN NEVER STOP DOING THAT DANCE." I TOLD HER I'D NEVER STOP.

UH, OH, OH, #1 SALSA DANCER IN THE LEAGUE!

IT WASN'T LONG BEFORE GIANTS FANS CAME UP WITH A SWEET SERENADE FOR THE TOE-TAPPING WIDE RECEIVER.

CRUZ!!

WHAT'S THAT FEEL LIKE?

IT'S GREAT. I GET GOOSEBUMPS EVERY SINGLE TIME. EVERY SINGLE TIME I HEAR IT. IT'S THE CRAZIEST FEELING IN THE WORLD TO HAVE AN ENTIRE STADIUM JUST YELL YOUR LAST NAME LIKE THAT.
