### **02:49:40 - RED BRYANT/JACOB GREEN**

A LOT OF PEOPLE SAY THAT YOU MARRY SOMEBODY THAT KIND OF REMINDS YOU OF YOUR DAD. I THINK THEY'RE A LOT ALIKE IN WAYS. SOMETIMES WHEN I'M LIVING MY LIFE HERE AND AT THE GAMES, I JUST THINK BACK. I'M LIKE, "THIS IS CRAZY." I DO REMEMBER GOING TO THE GAMES, MY SISTERS AND I. I DO REMEMBER BEING AROUND THE TEAM A LOT AND JUST HIS TEAMMATES AND THEIR FAMILIES. I DIDN'T REALLY KNOW LIKE THE RULES OF FOOTBALL WHEN I WAS 8 YRS. OLD BUT I DID KNOW HE WAS GOOD.

JANELLE'S FATHER WAS BETTER THAN GOOD. HE WAS ONE OF SEATTLE'S ALL-TIME GREATS.

DEFENSIVE END JACOB GREEN PLAYED 12 SEASONS FOR THE SEAHAWKS, AND IS THE TEAM'S ALL-TIME SACK LEADER.

IN 1995, GREEN'S FAMILY, INCLUDING OLDEST DAUGHTER JANELLE, SAW HIM INDUCTED INTO THE SEAHAWKS RING OF HONOR.

YEARS LATER, JANELLE WENT ON TO PLAY SOCCER AT TEXAS A & M, THE SAME SCHOOL WHERE HER DAD STARRED. IT WAS THERE THAT SHE MET ANOTHER FOOTBALL PLAYER WHO BECAME DEAR TO HER HEART – A DEFENSIVE LINEMAN NAMED RED BRYANT.

I THINK WHEN I FIRST MET RED, I DON'T THINK HE KNEW WHO MY DAD WAS. I DO REMEMBER BEING A LITTLE BIT NERVOUS WHENEVER HE FIRST CAME TO MY HOUSE.

HAVING 3 DAUGHTERS, YOU ALWAYS GOT YOUR EYE ON YOUNG MEN THAT COME AROUND. SO MY FIRST IMPRESSION WAS, "WHO ARE YOU? WHY ARE YOU COMING...WHAT DO YOU WANT?" I KIND OF CHECKED HIM OUT AT FIRST.

WHEN ME AND JANELLE FIRST STARTED DATING HER MOM, HER 2 SISTERS, EVEN THE CAT AND THE 2 DOGS, EVERYBODY LOVED ME. BUT HE WAS LIKE, "I DON'T KNOW THIS YOUNG FELLA JUST YET."

IT TURNS OUT JACOB GREEN WOULD HAVE A LOT IN COMMON WITH HIS FUTURE SON-IN-LAW.

IN 2008, BRYANT WAS DRAFTED IN THE FOURTH ROUND BY – OF ALL TEAMS – THE SEATTLE SEAHAWKS. HE WAS GIVEN JACOB GREEN'S NO. 79, AND WAS EVENTUALLY SWITCHED FROM DEFENSIVE TACKLE TO GREEN'S OLD POSITION OF DEFENSIVE END.

OVER THE PAST TWO SEASONS, BIG RED HAS BECOME A BIG FORCE, AND A BIG VOICE, FOR ONE OF FOOTBALL'S TOP DEFENSES.

ALL I ASK IS GIVE ME EVERYTHING YOU GOT ON EVERY PLAY! IF YOU DO THAT AND DO YOUR JOB, WE'LL WIN TODAY.

CARROLL - HE'S SUCH A SENTIMENTAL KID. HE'S GOT SUCH A BIG HEART AND HE WEARS IT ON HIS SLEEVE.

BRYANT, YOU LOOK SO DAMN HAPPY I SEE YOUR GOOSEBUMPS!

I LOVE IT! I LOVE IT REF!

CARROLL - HE'S JUST BECOME A GUY YOU CAN REALLY COUNT ON TO DO SOMETHING, SAY SOMETHING THAT MAKES EVERYBODY MOVE A LITTLE BIT.

TACKLE LEFT. TACKLE LEFT. LISTEN TO ME! (ALRIGHT, TACKLE LEFT.)

AS FAR AS JUST A PURE TALENT ON THE FIELD, HE IS ONE OF THE MOST DOMINANT DEFENSIVE LINEMEN IN THE NFL. // HE JUST CAN TAKE 2 GUYS AND DRIVE THEM INTO THE BACKFIELD 1 ARM AT A TIME. I CALL IT UNCLE

STRENGTH. YOU KNOW, LIKE WHEN YOU'RE AT A COOKOUT OR SOMETHING AND YOU JUST SLAP BOX AND WRESTLING WITH YOUR UNCLE. YOU'RE LIKE, "MAN, YOU'RE A FAT BOY. MAN, HOW YOU SO STRONG LIKE THAT, YOU KNOW?!" THAT'S LIKE RED BRYANT STRENGTH.

IN 2011, BRYANT WAS PRESENTED THE SEAHAWKS STEVE LARGENT AWARD, THE SAME AWARD JACOB GREEN WON TWO DECADES EARLIER.

BUT BIG RED WILL NEED A LOT OF BIG SEASONS IF HE HOPES TO LEAVE THE SAME MARK IN SEATTLE AS HIS FATHER-IN-LAW.

I STILL GOT A LOT OF WORK TO DO. YOU KNOW WHAT I MEAN? HE GOT ALL THE BRAGGING RIGHTS RIGHT NOW. IF YOU LOOK AT THE TAPE OF MR. GREEN, WHETHER IT BE A HIGHLIGHT OF ANY FOOTAGE, HE MASTERED THE ART OF GETTING TO THE QB, AND I GOT A COUPLE MOVES THAT I'M GONNA STEAL FROM HIM TO DO IT!

THEY HAVE DIFFERENT BODY TYPES AND STYLES. BUT WHAT TIES THEM TOGETHER IS JUST THAT EXPLOSIVE DISRUPTIVENESS. AND THEN THEIR RELENTLESS PURSUIT. IN 2011, BRYANT SET A TEAM RECORD WITH FOUR BLOCKED KICKS IN A SINGLE SEASON, THE SAME TOTAL JACOB GREEN HAD IN HIS ENTIRE CAREER.

RADIO – 23 YD. F.G. ATTEMPT BY GRAHAM GANOW. BALL IS BLOCKED! HOW ABOUT THAT?! WAS IT BIG RED AGAIN?!

OH MY GOD!!

RADIO – BARBER THE SINGLE SETBACK. PLAY FAKE TO HIM. HE IS HIT! THE BALL'S INTERCEPTED! IT'S BIG RED BRYANT! HE'S GONNA TAKE IT IN!! AND

RED AT 300-PLUS LBS. HIGH-STEPS IT INTO THE END ZONE!! HE LOOKS PRETTY GOOD DOING IT TOO. I DIDN'T KNOW THE BIG MAN HAD THAT TYPE OF STRIDE.

THAT'S GREAT.

RED'S ONE SCORE HAS NOTHING ON HIS FATHER-IN-LAW'S FOUR CAREER TOUCHDOWNS.

IS THAT THE QB TRYING TO GET YOU?

BUT THE FACT THAT NOT ONLY IS HE JACOB GREEN'S SON-IN-LAW BUT HE'S PRESENTED JACOB WITH THEIR FIRST GRANDCHILD. JUST THE FACT THAT HE CALLS HIM MR. GREEN. I MEAN IT KIND OF GIVES IT THAT NORMAN ROCKWELL...A LITTLE BIT MORE HOMESPUN FEEL TO IT.
