ANOTHER – JUST TELLING TEAMMATES WHAT TO DO.

YEA. RUN TO THE GOAL POST AND CATCH IT.

BUT WE PREFER THE KISS METHOD.

KEEP IT SIMPLE, STUPID.

RADIO - 58 SECONDS LEFT.

YOU'RE GONNA CALL A SPRINT OPTION. YOU DON'T GET WHAT YOU WANT, YOU SIMPLY THROW THE BALL AWAY.

THE FRIENDSHIP JUST GREW AND GREW AND GREW. HE AND I DID A LOT OF THINGS TOGETHER.

YOU KNOW THEY SAY OPPOSITES ATTRACT, AND THESE 2 GUYS WAS TOTALLY OPPOSITE! BUT THEY HAD A BEAUTIFUL RELATIONSHIP.

THAT RELATIONSHIP INTENSIFIED WHEN SOLOMON WAS DIAGNOSED WITH CANCER IN APRIL OF 2011.

WHEN FREDDIE WENT TO THE HOSPITAL, EDDIE WAS THERE EVERY OTHER DAY IF HE WASN'T THERE EVERYDAY.

I'D GO BACK AND I'D SIT WITH HIM BECAUSE HE WAS SCARED. WE JUST TALKED, WHEN HE WAS ABLE, ABOUT THE OLD DAYS. THE LAUGHS WE HAD.

ACTUALLY THE DAY THAT FREDDIE PASSED AWAY, EDDIE LEFT AN HOUR BEFORE HE PASSED AWAY. HE WAS THERE THE WHOLE TIME. SO HE KNEW THAT HIS FRIEND WAS ALWAYS THERE WITH HIM.

PEOPLE SCRATCH THEIR HEADS ABOUT OUR FRIENDSHIP. THEY JUST COULDN'T FIGURE IT OUT. FREDDIE LOVED ME WHEN I WAS ON TOP AND HE EVEN LOVED ME MORE WHEN I WASN'T. MANY PEOPLE THINK THAT HE WANTED TO BE CLOSE TO ME BUT, THE TRUTH IS, I WANTED TO BE CLOSE TO HIM. HE WAS MY BEST FRIEND.

I THINK EDDIE FIGURED OUT WHAT IT WAS THAT FREDDIE WAS ABOUT, AND IT HAD NOTHING TO DO WITH WANTING SOMETHING, AND I'M NOT SURE IF THERE'S TOO MANY PEOPLE IN A BILLIONAIRE'S LIFE THAT DON'T WANT SOMETHING PRETTY BAD FROM HIM. FREDDIE NEVER WANTED ANYTHING.

I MEAN COME ON JERRY. FREDDIE WAS JUST FREDDIE. HE DID EVERYTHING THAT HE COULD FOR EVERYBODY. HOW COULD YOU NOT LOVE HIM?

HE MISSES FREDDIE A LOT. I KNOW HE'S GOT A BIG VOID, A BIG VOID. IT'S JUST AS HARD FOR HIM AS IT IS FOR ME I'M SURE. YOU CAN TELL SOMETIMES HIS VOICE CRACKS. MY VOICE CRACKS AND HE'S LIKE, "I DON'T KNOW WHAT WE'RE GONNA DO BUT WE'LL GET THROUGH IT."

AS FAR AS I'M CONCERNED, FREDDIE LIVES. HE LIVES IN MY HEART. HE LIVES IN MY SOUL; AND ALL MY YEARS FROM 1977 ON, THE THOUSANDS OF PLAYERS THAT PASSED THROUGH THE 49ER DOORS, I HAVE DEEP RELATIONSHIPS WITH A LOT OF THEM. NO ONE EVER WILL BE AS CLOSE TO ME AS FREDDIE SOLOMON.
