FOUR PLAYS AFTER THE FUMBLE RECOVERY, FLACCO EXTENDED BALTIMORE'S LEAD.

(RADIO – BOLDIN TD; "CAN'T RELAX ON BRADY FOR A SECOND")

BUT THIS WASN'T VINTAGE TOM BRADY. FOR MUCH OF THE GAME, HE WAS OUT OF SYNC, AND OFF TARGET.

(RADIO – 4TH DOWN INCOMPLETION; FLACCO SIDELINE)

WITH EACH DEFENSIVE STAND, THE RAVENS WERE A STEP CLOSER TO NEW ORLEANS.

(RADIO – ELLERBEE INT.; CLINCHING INT.)

THEY HAVE BEEN SO CLOSE, SO MANY SEASONS. // NOW, THIS GROUP OF RAVENS THAT HAS BEEN CHASING A CHAMPIONSHIP, CAN FINALLY END THAT CHASE IN THE SUPER BOWL.
