CREDENTIALS FOR ENG NEWS CREWS:

If your station would like to request credentials for **ENG news-style coverage** at any NFL game, please note the following procedure:

- Requests must be made by the sports director.
- Complete the 2014 Credential Request Form and email it to Erica Booze at least 14 days before the game or event you plan to attend. The 2014 Credential Request Form is provided separately.
- **All requests must be made through the League Office - please do not contact teams directly.**

2014 INTERNATIONAL SERIES CREDENTIALS

WEMBLEY-STADIUM (London):

- Application forms will be sent via email in late July
- Game 1 Applications are due by August 29, 2014
- Game 2 & 3 Applications are due by September 26, 2014

PRO BOWL & SUPER BOWL CREDENTIALS

- Please register (if you have not already done so previously) at **www.nflmedia.com**.
- You can begin applying for credentials in mid-October via a special link that will be emailed to you in October.
- Applications are due by November 14, 2014

NFL Films will work with the teams' PR Department and Stadium Operations to provide credentials, commentary positions, camera positions, cabling, power, and parking. We will coordinate feeds from the U.S. network truck to your truck or commentary position.

Please note the following guidelines:

- **NFL Films coordination for on-site events is not optional.**
This is a policy to ensure international broadcasters get what they request and that NFL guidelines are followed.
- Requests must be received in writing at least **three weeks** prior to the game desired.
- If space for a commentary position or truck is not available, the request may be refused.
- The international broadcaster is responsible for a coordination fee. This coordination fee will cover all out-of-pocket costs associated with the broadcast.

SUPER BOWL XLIX REQUESTS:

If your station is planning to broadcast from Super Bowl XLIX in Phoenix on February 1, 2015, **you must fill out and return a "Letter of Intent" by September 12, 2014.** Signing this letter of intent does not obligate your station in any way, but it is necessary so the NFL can prepare for your needs.

CHAMPIONSHIP GAME AND PRO BOWL REQUESTS:

If your station is planning to broadcast live from the AFC or NFC Championship Games on January 18, 2015 or from the Pro Bowl on January 25, 2015, **you must notify NFL Films no later than Friday, December 12, 2014.**
