I AIN'T TRYING TO PUT NO PRESSURE ON YOU BUT YOU KEEP RUNNING THE BALL LIKE THAT BRO, WE GONNA BE IN THAT POSTSEASON AND IT'S ON FROM THERE BRO.

MY CAREER WITH THE DALLAS COWBOYS STARTED BEING THE 2ND ROUND DRAFT PICK IN 1977 OUT OF U.N.L.V. I ALWAYS THOUGHT THAT THERE COULD BE A CHANCE WHERE I CAN COMPETE FOR THE JOB. IN DALLAS THE BACKUP QB, "YOU NEVER GOT TO PLAY." DANNY WHITE NEVER CAME OUT. ROGER NEVER CAME OUT. YEA, I DID STEP ON THE FIELD AND PLAY THE N.Y. JETS AND RUN THE CLOCK OUT. COACH LANDRY PUTS ME IN AT 3RD STRING QB TO RUN THE CLOCK OUT. AFTER THE GAME I REALIZE THE REASON WHY HE DID THIS IS BECAUSE ALL THE FANS SWARMED THE FIELD AND COACH LANDRY WANTED TO TAKE CARE OF THE STARS. HE DIDN'T WANT ROGER AND DANNY AND EVERYBODY ELSE TO GET IN ANY OF HARM'S WAY OF THE FANS. HE LEFT ME OUT THERE!

THANKSGIVING DAY OF 1981 WAS MY REAL FIRST BG CHANCE TO PLAY. DANNY WHITE GETS KNOCKED OUT OF THE GAME. I GET TO COME IN. O.K. SO I'M PRETTY EXCITED ABOUT THIS.

RADIO - AT QB. DROPS TO THROW.

AND I HIT TONY HILL ON A BEAUTIFUL 55 YD. POST-PATTERN AND TONY THE THRILL HILL GETS CAUGHT FROM BEHIND. HE WOULD'VE GONE FOR 80 IF HE WOULD'VE BEEN A 4.4. INSTEAD OF 4.45.

SO WE WENT ON AND SCORED THE TD. TOOK THE LEAD AND WON THE GAME.

AFTER THANKSGIVING GLENN CARANO HAD SOMETHING EXTRA TO BE THANKFUL FOR. IT TOOK 5 YRS. BUT HE WOULD FINALLY BE STARTING AN NFL GAME THE NEXT WEEK IN BALT.

ROGER USED TO ALWAYS GET A PHONE CALL FROM COACH LANDRY ON THE NIGHT BEFORE THE GAME. SO I WAS IN MY HOTEL ROOM WAITING FOR THAT PHONE CALL! I NEVER GOT IT!

STARTING OPPOSITE CARANO WAS DAVIS HUMM, ALSO MAKING HIS FIRST AND LAST NFL START. IT'S THE ONLY TIME IN HISTORY 2 ONE-AND ONLY'S HAVE SQUARED OFF.

I WAS DRAFTED IN THE 5TH ROUND BY THE OAKLAND RAIDERS. I'M A LEFT-HANDED QB, AND TO GO TO A SITUATION WITH KENNY STABLER, A LEFTIE OUT OF ALABAMA, I COULDN'T HAVE BEEN BETTER. EVERY QB COMES INTO THE LEAGUE GOING, YOU KNOW I'VE BEEN SITTING MY FIRST COUPLE YEARS, THEN I'M GONNA GET MY OPPORTUNITY TO GO IN AND PLAY. AND I THOUGHT I WOULD GET MY CHANCE WHEN SNAKE GOES DOWN. APPARENTLY,, I WASN'T THE QB OF THE FUTURE THEN AND THEY DRAFTED MARK WILSON.

YOU NEVER THINK YOU'RE NOT GONNA BE THE STARTER. THERE'S ALWAYS THAT EGO THING THAT YOU THINK, "I'LL GO ON AND I'LL GET MY CHANCE."

HIS CAREER APPEARED OVER IN 1981,, BUT IN MID-NOVEMBER, WITH INJURIES PILING UP THE BALT. COLTS REACHED OUT TO THE UNEMPLOYED QB.

I'M AT HOME ONE DAY AND.. ALL OF A SUDDEN, I GET A CALL. AND THEY CALL ME AND THEY GO, "O.K. BURT JONES IS DOWN. YOU'RE GONNA START FOR US AGAINST THE DALLAS COWBOYS." OF COURSE I WAS ECSTATIC TO BE BACK IN THE GAME. YOU FINALLY GET YOUR FIRST START AND IT WAS A PRETTY HUMBLING THING. FORGET ABOUT LEARNING GUY'S NAMES. I'M TRYING TO LEARN PLAY CALLS AND AUDIBLES.

HE MAY NOT HAVE KNOWN HIS TEAMMATES BUT HE KNEW HIS OPPOSING QB. HUMM, LIKE CARANO,, WAS A NEVADA SCHOOLBOY LEGEND. HE ALSO MENTORED THE YOUNGER CARANO.

WHEN I LEFT NEBRASKA, I GOT BACK HERE IN LAS VEGAS AND I CALLED RON MEYER WHO'S THE HEAD COACH AT U.N.L.V. AND I ASKED COACH. I SAID, "COACH,. CAN I COME THROW WITH YOUR QBS AND RECEIVERS?" AND HE SAYS, "YEA. I'VE GOT A YOUNG QB WHO I THINK IS GONNA BE A GREAT ONE." HE SAY, "IF YOU CAN WORK WITH HIM, YOU CAN COME WORKOUT ANY TIME YOU WANT." I SAID, "GREAT."

SO DAVID CAME OUT AND WE BECAME REAL GOOD FRIENDS. PLAYED BASKETBALL TOGETHER, WORKED OUT ALL THE TIME.

JUST LOVED HIM LIKE A BROTHER. WE BECAME FAST FRIENDS.

GLENN CARANO AND DAVID HUMM WERE MAKING THEIR FIRST AND ONLY STARTS IN THE SAME GAME. IT IS THE ONLY TIME IN NFL HISTORY THAT HAS HAPPENED.

WELL CARANO AND HUMM ALREADY .. THEIR RESPECTIVE TEAMS. SO LET'S KICK IT OFF.

YOU WALK AROUND WITH A DIFFERENT BOUNCE IN YOUR STEP. YOU'RE THE STARTING QB. WHEN I FIRST TOOK THE FIELD, I THINK I RAN A 4.4. THAT DAY.

IT WAS SO MUCH FUN TO RUN ON THAT FIELD AND SHAKE HANDS, AND TO HUG EACH OTHER. AND THEN TO PLAY THAT GAME AGAINST EACH OTHER.

YOU LOOK AT THE BALT. COLTS, #10, DAVID HUMM, 7 YRS. NFL EXPERIENCE. HIS FIRST START HOWEVER IN A REGULAR SEASON GAME.

I DIDN'T START GOOD. MY FIRST THROW WAS INTERCEPTED AND CAUGHT BY MY FRIEND JOHN DUTTON. SO, NO. IT DIDN'T START GOOD.

RADIO - HUMM DIDN'T PLAY FOR DAVID HUMM. HIS FIRST PASS. THE DALLAS COWBOYS,, LIKEWISE, WITH A YOUNG ROOKIE QB. AT LEAST ROOKIE IN THE SENSE THAT HE HAS NEVER OPENED AN NFL GAME IN THE REGULAR SEASON. LANCE CARANO. CARANO TO THROW. HE NEEDS 6. HE'S GOT A MAN OPEN OVER THE MIDDLE. GOES TO THROW CORNER PATTERN. COMPLETE. FIRST DOWN.

THAT'S DREW PEARSON RIGHT THERE MAN. DREW PEARSON AT HIS BEST RIGHT THERE.

1:55:11;13 - RADIO - MOTION TO THE NEAR SIDE. TOUCHDOWN COWBOYS, RON SPRING. CARANO IS COMING TO THAT POINT WITH HIS CAREER. I MEAN THIS IS HIS 5TH YEAR. NEXT YEAR WILL BE HIS 6TH YEAR WHERE TOM LANDRY'S GONNA HAVE TO MAKE A DECISION.

THESE GUYS HIT IT RIGHT ON THE BUTTON. I NEED TO DO SOMETHING WITH MY CAREER.

RADIO - A BOOTLEG BY GLENN CARANO . WIDE OPEN. RON SPRINGS.

THAT'S JUST GREAT ATHLETIC ABILITY ON BEHALF OF THAT CARANO GUY.

RADIO - IT'S A GOOD THROW. TOUCHDOWN DALLAS.

MAN, I LOOKED GOOD FOR A MINUTE. WAS THAT MY CAREER I LOOKED GOOD FOR A MINUTE?!

RADIO - COWBOYS SHOW THE BLITZ. THEY'LL THROW EVERYTHING AT THE YOUNG QB, DAVID HUMM. TRY TO RATTLE HIM, SHAKE HIS CONFIDENCE EARLY. DALLAS JUMPED OFFSIDE. DOWN GOES HUMM.

OH GOD. TOUGH DAY IN BALT. FOR DAVID. HE'S FACING THAT VICIOUS DALLAS COWBOY FRONT 4.

RADIO - INCOMPLETE.

WE WEREN'T A GREAT TEAM WITH THE COLTS,, AND WE DIDN'T STAND A BIG CHANCE AGAINST THIS DALLAS TEAM.

RADIO - IT'S A NO LOSE SITUATION FOR DAVID HUMM, AND HE'S SO, HE'S THAT KIND OF AN ENGAGING PERSONALITY WHERE HE UNDERSTANDS THAT, LOOK, IF HE MAKES IT IT'S WONDERFUL. IF HE DOESN'T, THERE ARE OTHER THINGS IN LIFE.

IT'S A UNIQUE DAY FOR DAVIS AND MYSELF IN OUR LIVES; AND AT LEAST STARTING 1 GAME FOR THE DALLAS COWBOYS WAS A BIG DEAL FOR ME.

CARANO NEVER STARTED AGAIN. TODAY HE WORKS IN THE CASINO BUSINESS IN RENO. HE HAS 3 DAUGHTERS. ONE WHO IS MMA CHAMPION AND ACTRESS, GINA CARANO; AND HE MIGHT BE THE ONLY ONE AND ONLY WITH A STREET NAMED AFTER HIM.

JERRY JONES BUILT THE DALLAS COWBOYS PRACTICE FACILITY OUT IN VALLEY RANCH. THE DEVELOPER WHO BUILT THE DEVELOPMENT AROUND THE VALLEY RANCH NAMED ALL THE STREETS AFTER DALLAS COWBOYS. I HAVE A STREET NAMED AFTER ME. IT'S CARANO CIRCLE AT THE INTERSECTION OF AVENUE, CHAMPIONS AND CARANO CIRCLE. I'M REALLY THANKFUL FOR THAT AND HOPE IT'LL BE THERE FOREVER. I THINK IT'S CIRCLE. IT COULD BE COURT BUT I THINK IT IS CIRCLE.

HE KNOWS FROM WATCHING HIS BROTHER DAVID, WITH THE ADVERSITY HE HAD IN THE EXPANSION TEAM. THIS KID'LL BE ABLE TO OVERCOME THIS AND HE'S GOT A BRIGHT FUTURE AHEAD OF HIM.

THE POST FOOTBALL ROAD FOR HUMM, WHO CURRENTLY DOES RAIDERS RADIO, HAS NOT BEEN EASY.

I WAS DIAGNOSED WITH MULTIPLE SCLEROSIS IN 1988. IT ATTACKS THE NERVOUS SYSTEM. THERE'S NO CURE FOR IT YET. AND HERE I AM 26 YRS. LATER AND I'M STILL DEALING WITH IT. I CAN'T WALK NOW. I'VE BEEN IN A WHEELCHAIR FOR 16 YRS. IT HURTS. THERE'S PAIN AND THE FATIGUE IS THE BIGGEST PROBLEM. IT'S A CHALLENGE AND IT'S BEEN A FIGHT BUT MY LIFE'S VERY GOOD. I'VE BEEN DOING RADIO BROADCASTS FROM MY HOME IN LAS VEGAS. I'VE GOT A BEAUTIFUL DAUGHTER THAT I LOVE WITH ALL MY HEART. I'VE GOT TOO MUCH TO LIVE FOR..

IF YOU TALK TO HIM YOU WOULD NEVER KNOW THAT HE'S BEEN SUFFERING FROM M.S. AND THIS TERRIBLE DISEASE. I LOVE HIM LIKE A BROTHER. HE'S THE BEST. I TOOK A COUPLE FRIENDS, FORMER BUFFALO BILLS TEAMMATES

OF DAVID. PHIL VILLAPIANO, CONRAD DOBLER. WE JUMPED ON A PLANE OUT OF RENO ONE THURS. NIGHT, WEN TO LAS VEGAS, WENT TO DAVID'S HOUSE. I TOOK PIZZA AND BEER OVER TO HIS HOUSE AND WE HAD A BLAST.

WE TALK ALL THE TIME AND HE'S ALWAYS DOWN HERE, AND HE'S HELPING WITH MY DAUGHTER. WE HAVE A FRIENDSHIP THAT GOES SO SO SO DEEP AND SO FAR.

PRETTY AMAZING THAT 2 FRIENDS, ME AND DAVID HUMM. WE GET TO GO ON AND START OUR ONLY NFL GAMES, AND WE'RE STARTING AGAINST EACH OTHER. WE CAN TALK ABOUT IT FOR YEARS TO COME.
