I GOTTA TRY A BACK SHOULDER FADE RIGHT HERE.

THE BACK SHOULDER FADE IS TAKING OVER FOOTBALL.

RADIO - THIS IS GREAT TIMING. BALL'S RIGHT THERE. HE DON'T HAVE A SHOT. DWAYNE BOWE WITH A BACK SHOULDER THROW!

WATCH THE BACK SHOULDER.

BE READY FOR A BACK SHOULDER RODDY.

RADIO - THERE WE GO. THE BACK SHOULDER CATCH.

BACK SHOULDERS IT LOOKS LIKE.

BE READY FOR THE BACK SHOULDER, O.K.?

DESCRIBING WHAT IT IS IS ALMOST AS DIFFICULT AS STOPPING IT.

I'M A RECEIVER AND I'M RUNNING THIS DIRECTION, AND YOU'RE THE DEFENDER AND YOU'RE FACING ME.

THE DEFENDER IS BETWEEN THE QB AND THE BALL EXCEPT HE DOESN'T HAVE EYES IN THE BACK OF HIS HEAD.

YOU'RE PLAYING THE FADE BALL WHICH IS ON THE TOP SHOULDER. THE BACK SHOULDER'S AN EASY THROW TO MAKE.

YOU GOT A GUY RUNNING FULL SPEED DOWN THE FIELD AND YOU'RE SUPPOSED TO GO STRIDE-FOR-STRIDE WITH HIM. THE NEXT THING YOU KNOW HE'S GOT HIS VISION BACK ON THE QB AND HE SEES THE BALL.

YOU WANT TO TAKE SOME AIR OUT OF THE PASS AND PUT IT ON THE BACK SHOULDER OF THE RECEIVER.

YOUR MOMENTUM CARRIES YOU DOWN THE FIELD. I SLOW DOWN AND CATCH THE BALL. STEP OUT OF BOUNDS OR STEP IN THE END ZONE.

RADIO - BRADY THROWS THE BALL BACK SHOULDER AND IT'S A TOUCHDOWN!

WHEN YOU PRESSED THE. THAT WAS PERFECT. THAT'S THE WHOLE THING RIGHT THERE.

QBS ARE TAUGHT TO LEAD RECEIVERS. RECEIVERS WANT TO BEAT DEF. BACKS.

RADIO - WELCOME BACK JOSH GORDON!

BUT BY LOOKING BACK, OFFENSES HAVE EVOLVED.

THE NFL DEFINITION OF OPEN IS A LITTLE DIFFERENT THAN ALL OTHER LEVELS OF FOOTBALL.

ANYTIME A DEFENDER'S BACK IS TURNED, YOU TELL HIM THE RECEIVER'S OPEN. HE'S EITHER COVERING ONE HAND OR THE OTHER.

THE BACK SHOULDER PASS DOES NOT START IN THE HUDDLE.

GET READY FOR A BACK SHOULDER POSSIBLY.

WELL, SORT OF.

THE BACK SHOULDER THROW IS MORE OF A ROUTE ADJUSTMENT BASED ON HOW THE DEFENDER'S PLAYING A SPECIFIC ROUTE.

WHEN A RECEIVER RUNS A GO, ALSO KNOWN AS A 9 ROUTE, THE QB CAN OPT TO THROW TO HIS BACK SHOULDER IF THE DEFENDER IS PLAYING FOR THE DEEP BALL

THE MINUTE THAT GUY GOES TO THE TOP YOU KNOW IT'S A BACK SHOULDER RUN? YES.

IT'LL ONLY BE A BACK SHOULDER IF IT'S PRESSED AND THE BACK'S TURNED. IF NOT WE'RE GONNA LAY IT UP.

IF HE PLAY HIGH SHOULDER, HE'S OUT. BACK SHOULDER. KILLS HIM.

RADIO - THROWS TO THE END ZONE. TOUCHDOWN!

IT'S JUST ANOTHER WAY TO GET A COMPLETION ON THE 9 ROUTE WHEN IT'S COVERED.

YOU KNOW EVERYONE THINKS YOU'RE GONNA RUN UP OVER THE TOP AND YOU GOTTA HAVE A QB WHO CAN THROW IT.

WHEN HE TURNS HIS HEAD, ALL YOU GOTTA DO IS JUST BACK SHOULDER HIM. YEA, THERE'S NO ONE THERE.

I THINK THE KEY TO THE BACK SHOULDER IS YOU CAN'T GO INTO THE ROUTE SAYING IT'S A BACK SHOULDER BECAUSE THE D.B. WILL NEVER BUY IT. SO THAT'S ONE OF THE BIG COACHING POINTS FOR US IS YOU GOTTA GO. YOU GOTTA MAKE HIM FEEL LIKE IT'S A FADE INTO THE CORNER OF THE END ZONE OR A GO ROUTE UP THE SIDELINES. GET HIM RUNNING OUT OF CONTROL, AND THEN YOU THROW IT BACK BEHIND HIM.

RADIO - THAT BACK SHOULDER FADE AND THEY WEREN'T AFRAID TO THROW IT OVER THE TOP TO RICHARD SHERMAN.

RADIO - JAY'S THROWING BACK SHOULDER. TOUCHDOWN BRANDON MARSHALL!

NO ONE KNOWS THE TRUE GENESIS OF THE BACK SHOULDER PASS.

I DON'T REMEMBER EVER THROWING THOSE. AT THAT TIME IT WAS THROW A GO-ROUTE 44 YDS., FEATHERING INTO A RECEIVER'S HANDS.

WE DON'T KNOW WHERE IT STARTED BUT WHOEVER DID IT, IT'S A GREAT IDEA AND IT'S BEEN WORKING.

THERE IS SOME EVIDENCE THAT IT'S MORE THAN JUST A RECENT FAD.

RADIO - ...TO THE RIGHT CORNER OF THE END ZONE. TOUCHDOWN KANSAS CITY!

I THINK IF YOU GO BACK AND LOOK AT NAMATH, YOU'LL SEE SOME BACK SHOULDERS THAT I THINK WERE PROBABLY PRETTY GOOD. HE CERTAINLY HAD A KNACK FOR IT.

THE FIRST GUY THAT I SAW THAT WAS THE BEST AT IT WAS WARREN MOON WITH THE OILERS, AND EVERYBODY TRYING TO COPY IT.

THAT WAS THE EASY LANE THERE.

LIKE ANY OFFENSIVE EVOLUTION, DEFENSES MUST NOW DEVISE A WAY TO STOP IT.

HOW CAN A D.B. STOP THAT?

CAN'T. I WAS JUST TALKING TO PATRICK PETERSON AND HE WAS UST LIKE, MAN, THIS IS THE HARDEST THING TO EVER STOP RIGHT THERE.

ANTICIPATE THAT ONE. I TRIED. O.K. I HAD THAT BACK SHOULDER. EXACTLY.

WHEN IT'S WELL-EXECUTED, YOU CAN'T DEFEND IT AND YOU DON'T WANT GUYS TO GET FRUSTRATED WITH IT.

RADIO - ONE OF THE MOST DIFFICULT PASSES FOR A CORNER TO COVER.

I DON'T WANT TO GIVE UP ALL MY TIPS BUT THE THING THAT THEY'RE TEACHING US NOW, YOU CAN'T TRY TO INTERCEPT IT, USUALLY. BUT IF YOU'RE PLAYING EVEN WITH THEM AND THEY'RE LOOKING LIKE UP FOR THE BALL TO COME, IT'S USUALLY OUT IN FRONT OF THEM FADE. IF THEY START LOOKING DIRECTLY BACK, THEN IT'S COMING BACK SHOULDER.

IT'S NOT IMPOSSIBLE TO COVER BUT IT'S PRETTY CLOSE.

IF YOU FEEL THAT A RECEIVER STARTS TO KIND OF LEAN BACK TO THE BACK SHOULDER, YOU TRY TO GET AN ARM INTO THE CATCH SPOT AS MUCH AS YOU CAN. REALLY, WHAT ELSE CAN YOU DO?

YOU DEFINITELY HAVE TO BE CRAFTY. YOU HAVE TO BE SAVVY. YOU GOTTA BE SMART.

IT ALSO HELPS TO BE REALLY GOOD.

RADIO - RICHARD SHERMAN ON A BACK SHOULDER THROW, LEAPS BACK. MAKES A ONE-HANDED CATCH.

BUT MOST OF THE TIME EVEN GREAT COVERAGE ISN'T ENOUGH AGAINST THE MOST UNSTOPPABLE PLAY IN FOOTBALL.

DAMN, I GAVE UP THAT BACK SHOULDER. I JUST STUCK MY HAND OUT TOO LATE.

A VERY ACCOMPLISHED FAMILY.

OH THAT'S NICE.

BOTH BROTHERS HAVE BEEN ALL PRO NFL OFFENSIVE LINEMEN.

THEIR SISTER IS A MUSICIAN WHO HAS COMPETED ON "AMERICAN IDOL."

AND THIS MODERN FAMILY AFFAIR ALL BEGAN WITH A RUGGED YOUNG CENTER... AND A PAGEANT QUEEN.

CHERYL VAN CLEAVE WAS CROWNED MISS CALIFORNIA IN 1981... AND PARTICIPATED IN THAT YEAR'S MISS AMERICA PAGEANT.

WE'RE GONNA WATCH DADDY COACH HERE IN A MINUTE. WHERE'S DADDY AT? I DON'T KNOW. YOU DON'T KNOW. OH, THERE HE IS OVER THERE.

WHO HAS YOUNGER BROTHERS? RAISE YOUR HAND. YOUNGER BROTHERS? THEY CAN BE ANNOYING SOMETIMES. I KNOW MINE CAN. SO JUST PRETEND HE'S YOUR YOUNGER BROTHER, AND COME OFF THE BALL AND HIT THESE BAGS HARD, O.K.?

ON THIS DAY, OLDER BROTHER'S TEAM WOULD PREVAIL.

RADIO - THROWS END ZONE. IT'S COMPLETE. STEVE SMITH LEFT SIDE. TOUCHDOWN CAROLINA PANTHERS.

RYAN HAD A GOOD ...

THERE'S NEVER A MOMENT WHERE HE'S NOT GRADING US. MY DAD'S A GUY ...HE'S IN THE GAME THE WHOLE TIME LOOKING AT BINOCULARS. JUST LOOKING. DOESN'T TALK TO ANYBODY. ATHLETICALLY, HE'S A LOT MORE GIFTED. HE GOT ALL THE BETTER GENES. LOOK-WISE, MUCH MORE HANDSOME.

YOU KNOW I LOVE PEOPLE TO KNOW THAT THESE 2 GUYS AND MY DAUGHTER ARE JUST SUCH GOOD KIDS OUTSIDE OF WHAT THEY DO. IT'S JUST BEEN A GREAT SO FAR FOR THE KALIL FAMILY.
