SO THIS IS KIND OF OUR OFFICE HERE AND WHERE THE DAY-TO-DAY OPERATIONS HAPPEN. THERE'S A LOT OF PICTURES HERE DEPICT SOME OF THE GOOD THINGS THAT ARE GOING ON IN OUR COMMUNITY AND HELPING CHILDREN THAT ARE GOING THROUGH CANCER. AND THE REASON BEHIND THE FOUNDATION IS A TRAGIC LOSS FOR ANY PARENT THAT'S OUT THERE THAT LOVES THEIR CHILDREN. ANYTIME YOU LOSE A CHILD IT'S NOT HOW THE CIRCLE OF LIFE WAS MEANT TO BE. YOU'RE NOT SUPPOSED TO BURY YOUR CHILDREN BEFORE YOURSELVES. BUT THAT'S WHAT LIFE GAVE US AND THE HARD KNOCKS THAT CAME WITH IT, IT WASN'T EASY. IT JUST DIDN'T SAY, HEY, WHEN ANDREW PASSED AWAY THE PAIN'S OVER WITH. THE PAIN IS JUST STARTING. EVERY ONE OF US GOES THROUGH SOMETHING IN OUR LIVES THAT CHANGES YOUR DYNAMICS. IT'S HOW YOU DEAL WITH IT AND HOW YOU TRANSFORM INTO SOMETHING GOOD.

WE GET AN OPPORTUNITY HERE TO SHOWCASE WHAT THE RYPIEN FOUNDATION'S ALL ABOUT AND FOR US TO TELL OUR STORY, AND HOW WE WENT THROUGH WHAT WE WENT THROUGH AND WERE ABLE TO HELP OTHERS OUT.

FOLLOWING THE LOSS OF HIS 3 YR. OLD SON, RYPIEN CREATED A NONPROFIT ORG. TO ASSIST FAMILIES FIGHTING CHILDHOOD CANCER IN THE PACIFIC NORTHWEST.

WHAT'S YOUR SPORT, BASKETBALL? SOCCER. SOCCER? SOCCER! NICE. YOU JUST DO IT ALL, DON'T YA? YEA.

VOLUNTEERING AT THE SAME HOSPITAL THAT CARED FOR HER BROTHER WAS A FORM OF THERAPY FOR ANGELA. BUT IN 2010 AN URGENT MEDICAL SITUATION RETURNED HER TO THE EMERGENCY CENTER.

I WAS ONLY 19YRS. OLD AND I WAS A YOUNG SINGLE TEEN MOM, AND I'M SITTING THERE WITH A 10 MTH. OLD BABY WHO'S LETHARGIC AND NOT RESPONDING TO MY VOICE, MY TOUCH. NOTHING. IT WAS JUST CRAZY. MY WORLD WAS JUST TURNED UPSIDE DOWN.

ANGELA'S DAUGHTER MELIA WAS DIAGNOSED WITH A BRAIN INFECTION AND RUSHED INTO EMERGENCY SURGERY. AFTER A LENGTHY RECOVERY, SHE RETURNED TO FULL HEALTH. ANGELA WAS FAR LESS RESILIENT.

OK, WHAT DO WE WANT TO START WITH, THE CORNERS? IT WAS ONE OF THOSE THINGS THAT MADE YOU KIND OF RELIVE WHAT YOU ALREADY WENT THROUGH, JUST YEARS LATER. I DEFINITELY WENT INTO A DEPRESSION AND DIDN'T KNOW HOW TO COME OUT OF IT. LIVING WITH MY PARENTS LIKE, WHAT AM I GONNA DO? I HAD NO IDEA WHAT TO DO. SO WE'RE SITTING ON THE COUCH ONE DAY FLIPPING THROUGH THE CHANNELS AND I CAME ACROSS THE L.F.L. FANS ON TV.

HELLO L.F.L. FANS. MITCH

WE WATCHED IT, WHAT, FOR LIKE A COUPLE MINUTES JUST TO SEE, AND HE WAS LIKE, WOW, THEY'RE REALLY PLAYING FOOTBALL.

RADIO - FOR MINNESOTA. HANDOFF AND THERE'S ANNIE .. MEETING THE RUNNER.

AND I LOOKED AT MY DAD AND I SAID I WANTED TO PLAY.

AND THAT'S ABOUT WHEN I SAID, YEA, YOU'RE COO COO FOR COCOA PUFFS HERE! SURE!

I REALLY NEEDED SOMETHING TO ..HUDDLE UP! LET'S GO! HUSTLE UP HERE! JUST TO GRAB ONTO AND FOCUS ON, AND TRY AND LIKE GET MY LIFE BACK ON TRACK.

RADIO - RYPIEN. SHE'S A LEADER OF THIS TEAM RIGHT NOW. 6 PTS. FOR SEATTLE.

AS A DAD, I AM JUST SO EAGER AND ANXIOUS TO WATCH HER PLAY. OUTSIDE OF THE UNIFORMS THEY WEAR, I DON'T REALLY HAVE A SAY IN THAT BUT...IT'S GREAT TO SEE HER ENERGY TRANSFERRED INTO SOMETHING THAT SHE REALLY LOVES. THE APPRECIATION OF THE GAME OF FOOTBALL. THE POSITION OF QB AND THE RESPONSIBILITIES; AND, MORE IMPORTANTLY, JUST WATCH HER GROW.
