GREEN BAY PACKERS @ MIAMI DOLPHINS

WHILE SOME STRUTTED THEIR STUFF EARLY, AARON RODGERS AND RYAN TANNEHILL SHOWED THEIR BEST MOVES IN THE SECOND HALF.

AFTER TRAILING THE ENTIRE GAME, THE DOLPHINS TOOK A 24 TO 17 4TH QUARTER LEAD.

NEW YORK GIANTS @ PHILADELPHIA EAGLES

AFTER THE GREAT BALL, THE GIANTS BIT ON A GREAT CALL.

THE EAGLES RUSHED FOR OVER 200 YARDS, THEIR HIGHEST OUTPUT OF THE YEAR.

AN EIGHT SACK NIGHT HELPED FUEL PHILLY'S FIRST SHUTOUT SINCE 1996 -- AS A GAME WITH AN INTENSE START CAME TO A RELAXED FINISH.

THOUGH IT WAS PAST THEIR BED TIME, CHIP KELLY'S EAGLES HEADED INTO THE BYE WEEK AT 5 AND 1...AND ENJOYING THE RIDE.

DALLAS COWBOYS @ SEATTLE SEAHAWKS

(HUDDLES – RADIO; BLOCKED PUNT FOR TD)

AFTER SEATTLE RACED TO A 10 TO NOTHING LEAD, DALLAS CONTROLLED THE FIRST HALF.

(DEZ – “IF THAT BALL’S IN THE AIR, I’M TAKIN THE ROCK”)

WHEN DEZ BRYANT WASN’T OPEN, ANOTHER RELIABLE TARGET WAS.

(RADIO – WITTEN TD; SIDELINE; EARL THOMAS – “KEEP FIGHTIN NOW”)

SEATTLE’S EARL THOMAS IS WIDELY REGARDED AS THE LEAGUE’S PREMIER SAFETY. / ENTERING SUNDAY, THOMAS AND THE DEFENSE HADN’T ALLOWED ANY BACK TO RUSH FOR MORE THAN 38 YARDS IN A GAME. / THE COWBOYS DEMARCO MURRAY HAD TOPPED 100 IN EACH OF THE FIRST FIVE GAMES.

(FAN – “YOU’RE GONNA FUMBLE THREE TIMES TODAY, AND GET 50 YARDS MAX!”)

MURRAY DIDN’T FUMBLE, BUT TWO COWBOYS TURNOVERS KEPT SEATTLE IN THE GAME.

(RADIO – ROMO FUMBLE; SDL - “IF YOU EVER WANT A TIME, NOW’S THE TIME!”)

THE SEAHAWKS HAD WON 19 OF THEIR PAST 20 AT HOME. IN THE FOURTH QUARTER, THE COWBOYS FACED A 23 TO 20 DEFICIT, AND A NEAR IMPOSSIBLE 3RD DOWN.

(RADIO – THIRD DOWN COMPLETION)

DALLAS WOULD OUTGAIN SEATTLE BY NEARLY 200 YARDS. ON THE GAME-WINNING DRIVE, MURRAY RUSHED FOR 46 YARDS, AND JOINED A LEGEND IN THE RECORD BOOK.

(RADIO – MURRAY TD; END OF GAME)

CHICAGO BEARS @ ATLANTA FALCONS

BIG ARM JAY CUTLER...PLUS HUGE CHICAGO RECEIVING TARGETS...
EQUALLED GIGANTIC PROBLEMS FOR THE FALCONS.

THE FALCONS BECAME SILENT.....BUT DEADLY.

CUTLER CUT LOOSE FOR THE SECOND-HIGHEST PASSING YARDAGE TOTAL
OF HIS CAREER -- THROWS THAT SET UP A PAIR OF SCORES FROM
CHICAGO'S FEATURE BACK.

CAROLINA PANTHERS @ CINCINNATI BENGALS

IN THE NFL, SELF DOUBTS MUST BE EXTINGUISHED QUICKLY TO RESTORE
CONFIDENCE.

GIOVANNI BERNARD HELPED PUT TO REST LAST WEEK'S BITTER LOSS WITH
THE NFL'S LONGEST RUN OF THE SEASON.

CAM NEWTON TOOK CHARGE, RUSHING FOR A TEAM-HIGH 107 YARDS.

BOTH OFFENSES SEEMED UNSTOPPABLE, COMBINING FOR 34 POINTS IN THE
