PLAYOFF RACES INTENSIFY AS WEEK 15 SHOWDOWNS LOOM

And now things get really intense!

The Seattle Seahawks are division champions. Eight other teams aim to win one of five remaining NFC invites to the playoff party, as the Road to Forty, as in Super Bowl XL, heats up even more throughout the league.

The surging Minnesota Vikings (8-5), winners of six consecutive games, aim to continue their winning ways when they host the Pittsburgh Steelers on Sunday. The first-place Chicago Bears (9-4), meanwhile, look to maintain a one-game advantage over the Vikes in the NFC North race when they welcome the Atlanta Falcons (8-5) to Soldier Field (Sunday, 8:30 P.M., ESPN).

In the NFC East, the 9-4 New York Giants host Kansas City on Saturday and seek to maintain a one-game lead over Dallas (8-5) and a two-game bulge over Washington (7-6), as those two venerable rivals meet at FedEx Field. In the NFC South, Tampa Bay and Carolina each sit at 9-4, while the Falcons loom one game off the pace.

The 11-2 Seahawks can secure a first-round bye with a win on Sunday in Tennessee against the Titans, as Seattle seeks a 10th consecutive win.

"We have the opportunity to do some wonderful things," says Seahawks head coach **MIKE HOLMGREN**. "And right now we are playing for something very important – home-field advantage and a first-round bye in the playoffs."
