MIAMI DOLPHINS HEAD COACH NICK SABAN
AS WEEK 9 MOTOROLA NFL COACH OF THE WEEK

Head coach **NICK SABAN** of the Miami Dolphins is the **Motorola NFL Coach of the Week** for games played on November 5-6, the NFL announced today.

Saban led his Dolphins into Soldier Field, home of the previously undefeated Chicago Bears, and came away with a 31-13 victory behind an inspired effort from his defense and a strong running attack led by Ronnie Brown. The Dolphins defense forced six turnovers, including an interception by defensive end Jason Taylor that he returned 20 yards for a touchdown to give Miami a 14-3 lead in the second quarter. Brown carried 29 times for 157 yards and quarterback Joey Harrington threw three touchdown passes to earn the Dolphins their second win of the season.

Saban was selected as Motorola NFL Coach of the Week from among three finalists by voters on NFL.com. The other finalists were head coaches **TONY DUNGY** of the Indianapolis Colts and **ROD MARINELLI** of the Detroit Lions.

In January, voting will be held on NFL.com to determine the Motorola NFL Coach of the Year.
