CHICAGO BEARS HEAD COACH LOVIE SMITH

Head coach **LOVIE SMITH** of the Chicago Bears is the **Motorola NFL Coach of the Week** for games played on October 1-2, the NFL announced today.

Smith is the head coach of the only undefeated team in the NFC after his Bears defeated the previously unbeaten Seattle Seahawks 37-6 on Sunday night.
