NFL.COM VOTERS SELECT PHILADELPHIA EAGLES HEAD COACH ANDY REID AS WEEK 5 MOTOROLA NFL COACH OF THE WEEK

Head coach **ANDY REID** of the Philadelphia Eagles is the **Motorola NFL Coach of the Week** for games played on October 8-9, the NFL announced today.

Reid coached Philadelphia to a 38-24 victory over the Dallas Cowboys on Sunday. The Eagles' offense accumulated 383 yards, with quarterback Donovan McNabb throwing touchdown passes of 40 and 87 yards and running for another score. The defense recorded seven sacks, three fumble recoveries and three interceptions, the last of which cornerback Lito Sheppard returned 102 yards for the game-sealing touchdown.

Reid was selected as Motorola NFL Coach of the Week from among three finalists by voters on NFL.com. The other finalists were head coaches **JACK DEL RIO** of the Jacksonville Jaguars and **MARTY SCHOTTENHEIMER** of the San Diego Chargers.
