NFL.COM VOTERS SELECT JACKSONVILLE JAGUARS HEAD COACH JACK DEL RIO AS WEEK 8 MOTOROLA NFL COACH OF THE WEEK

Head coach **JACK DEL RIO** of the Jacksonville Jaguars is the **Motorola NFL Coach of the Week** for games played on October 29-30, the NFL announced today.

Del Rio and the Jaguars visited Philadelphia on Sunday and defeated the Eagles 13-6. With quarterback David Garrard starting in place of the injured Byron Leftwich, Del Rio relied on the running game to move the football. Running backs Fred Taylor and Maurice Jones-Drew combined for 180 yards and one touchdown on 36 carries, and Garrard added 8 carries for 36 yards. The Jacksonville defense applied pressure to Eagles quarterback Donovan McNabb all day, sacking him four times, and held Philadelphia to 227 total yards of offense.

Del Rio was selected as Motorola NFL Coach of the Week from among three finalists by voters on NFL.com. The other finalists were head coaches **BRIAN BILLICK** of the Baltimore Ravens and **TONY DUNGY** of the Indianapolis Colts.

In January, voting will be held on NFL.com to determine the Motorola NFL Coach of the Year.
